



Re: Tricuro Scope of Work for Ukraine Delegation to Washington, DC - September 2020

I am delighted that Tricuro has been appointed by Guild to support a delegation of Ukraine officials on a forthcoming visit to Washington, DC. I write here with details of our scope of work and associated fee.

Objectives

Guild is a non-profit NGO in Ukraine that is privately funded and independent of Government. Guild brings together professionals from all walks of life to discuss political issues that affect businesspeople, academics, teachers and students. The organization's primary focus is corruption and the toll this has on all Ukrainians. It provides a voice for members and funds such activities as the forthcoming delegation with the objective of implementing positive change.

Guild is funding a visit to Washington, DC by representatives of the National Bank of Ukraine, the Export Import Bank of Ukraine, and the Office of the Prosecutor General of Ukraine. The purpose of the visit is to build relations between these Ukraine institutions and their counterparts in Washington, DC, as well as undertake a wider public affairs program.

Scope of Work

Tricuro's role includes the following:

Fees and Transparency

For this program in Washington DC, Tricuro will charge a one-off project fee of US\$58,000, 50% payable now and 50% payable in advance of the delegates' visit during the week of September 21. All associated expenses such as **translators**, **business-class** travel, and entertainment (dinners, room hire, etc.) will be payable 30 days in arrears.
