



Item 8: Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

The Registrant will engage in public and government relations, and investor outreach:

a) Government Relations:

The Registrant (sometimes accompanied by one or more representatives of the Foreign Principal) will meet with Members of Congress and officials in the Executive Branch of the U.S. Government. The latter will include national security and foreign policy officials, including the State Department and National Security Council. The purpose of these meetings is to encourage the U.S. to adopt legislation, and foreign policy that will promote U.S.-South Sudan strategic ties and removal of sanctions.

The Registrant, along with one or more representatives of the Foreign Principal on occasion, will also meet with Members of Congress and the U.S. Administration—including the Commerce Department, the Bureau of Industry and Security, the International Trade Administration, U.S. Trade Representative, U.S. Trade and Development Agency, the Department of State, the Department of Treasury, the U.S. International Development Finance Corporation (formerly OPIC), U.S.AID, other commercial and economic departments and agencies of the U.S. government, and non-government institutions such as the World Bank Group. The purpose of these meetings will be to support economic aid; promote removal of sanctions, promote investment and economic development; support peace-building, democracy, anti-corruption, and human rights; and develop stronger commercial and economic ties between the United States and South Sudan. The Registrant will also prepare informational materials for distribution to Members of Congress and their staffs as well as for Administration officials. These may include white papers, pamphlets, written reports, and digital media.

b) Public relations and investor outreach:

The Registrant's public relations work will focus on developing global media campaigns towards members of the media (reporters, bloggers, news outlets, etc.), think tanks, human rights organizations, thought leaders, investors, and other civil society members. The focus will be on economic development. The Registrant will engage with reporters and staff from think tanks, human rights organizations, non-governmental organizations, and investor groups to foster a better understanding of South Sudan and its investment opportunities. The Registrant will host events and disseminate informational materials. Representatives of Foreign Principal will occasionally attend these meetings and events.

c) The Registrant may also retain consultants, and other professional services, as needed, to assist in its work.

Dear Hon. Eng. Awow Daniel Chuang,

Per our recent discussion in the city of Juba, South Sudan, this letter memorializes the agreement of AZ Media PR Inc. ("AZ Media") to represent the government of the Republic of South Sudan (the "Government") with respect to the provision of services related to public relations, government relations, advocacy before members of the United States Congress, the Executive Branch of the United States, non-governmental institutions such as the World Bank Group, among others, and other interested parties, and investor outreach.

The objectives of the contracted services will be targeted to improving the public image and reputation of South Sudan in the United States and internationally, and to develop and implement public relations and communications strategies to assist the Government in communicating its message to the public in the United States and internationally to attract investment.

In exchange for providing the Government with the services described above, AZ Media will receive a payment in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Five hundred U.S. Dollars (\$280,500). The services will start upon full payment.

This letter constitutes the entire agreement between AZ Media and the Government with respect to the describes services and supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous arrangements, understandings and agreements, written or oral, between the parties related to this agreement.
