The German federal parliament's International Parliamentary Scholarship (IPS) program offers young college graduates from over 50 countries the chance to experience Germany's democratic system of governance up-close in Berlin.

The IPS program allows participants to gain first-hand knowledge of Germany's [#parliamentary](#) system and [#political](#) decision-making process during a three-month work placement with a Member of the German Parliament. Participants also take part in a rich educational program with the German political foundations and have the chance to enroll in university classes, spending a total of five months in the German capital (March 1 through July 31, 2024).

Requirements:

- U.S. citizenship
- College degree
- Very good (B2+) knowledge of German
- Knowledge of German politics, society and history
- Under the age of 30 at the start of the scholarship
