

Delegation of German Industry and Commerce in Washington, DC

The last two days we had the pleasure of hosting the German Federal Ministry of Food and Agriculture for an in-depth U.S. program focused on the agriculture and food sectors.

Led by Federal Minister Alois Rainer, the delegation brought together 14 representatives from the Ministry alongside 12 German companies and associations. Their visit fostered meaningful dialogue on transatlantic cooperation, emerging industry trends, and shared challenges across the agricultural value chain.

The program kicked off with a dynamic roundtable at DGIC featuring Washington-based think tanks and agriculture experts.
