You are cordially invited, in your capacity as Congressional staffer, to a **lunch roundtable discussion with the Ambassador of Azerbaijan** that will take place next Monday, **September 16 from 12:30PM-1:30PM Room 2247 in the Rayburn House Office Building.**

In this roundtable meeting, we will discuss US-Azerbaijan relations, Azerbaijan's role in European energy markets, Azerbaijan's expansion into clean energy, Azerbaijan-Israel relations, and most importantly, the normalization process between Azerbaijan and Armenia.

Armenia and Azerbaijan continue to engage in productive peace talks, recently agreeing on an outline of a peace deal. As Armenia and Azerbaijan reach this new stage of their peace negotiations, the Embassy can provide a robust and detailed update on the progress of the peace talks from the perspective of Azerbaijan.

Much of the focus and media coverage on the former conflict and current normalization process has been from the perspective of Armenia. Given the United States' role as an arbitrator for peace, it's important to understand the perspectives of both sides and give Azerbaijan equal levels of consideration as it navigates the normalization process with Armenia.

This briefing will give you a clearer understanding of the progress of the peace negotiations, the future of the Karabakh region, and the role Azerbaijan hopes to play in global diplomacy.
