CONTRACT FOR SERVICES

This contract is entered into between the Ministry of Communication and Medias of the Democratic Republic of Congo ("the Client"), 83 Avenue Tabu-Ley, Kinshasa, Congo and Ballard Partners, Inc. ("the Firm"), 601 Thirteenth Street NW, Suite 450N, Washington, D.C. 20005.

Recitals

Whereas the Client wishes to retain the services of the Firm in order that the Firm may provide strategic consulting and advocacy services to the Democratic Republic of Congo in connection with its business with the United States government; and

Whereas, the Firm wishes to provide such representation as the Client may from time to time require; and

Whereas, the parties have agreed to the terms under which the Firm will represent the Client and wish to memorialize their agreement in writing.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Term of Agreement. This agreement shall become effective on March 11, 2022 and shall remain effective until March 10, 2023 ("initial term"). This agreement shall automatically renew for successive one-year periods on the anniversary of the effective date of the agreement unless either party terminates the agreement. Upon renewal of the initial term, this agreement may be terminated within thirty (30) days written notice by either party.
- 2. <u>Duties of The Firm</u>. It shall be the Firm's duty to consult with the Client and advocate on its behalf those issues the Client deems necessary and appropriate before the U.S. Government. Issues and objectives may include, but not limited to, enhancing U.S. Democratic Republic of the Congo relations, strengthening of democratic institutions and rule of law, and advance economic growth. We will help recognize and promote the Democratic Republic of the Congo as an international leader of climate change, with equitable compensation for its carbon credits and allow it to position itself more effectively on the path of the protection of forest resources and national socio-economic development. It shall further be the Firm's duty to inform the Client of developments in legislation and U.S. policies relevant to the Client's issues and objectives.
- 3. <u>Duties of The Client</u>. It shall be the Client's duty to provide the Firm the information necessary to best represent the Client. It shall also be the Client's duty to timely compensate the Firm for its services.
- 4. <u>Compensation</u>. The Firm shall receive from the Client a fee of \$75,000 a month, payable in quarterly installments for this agreement, plus the reasonable costs associated with the

representation, including but not limited to, necessary registration fees; and travel expenses such as overseas hotel, air fare, car services and meals, excluding costs typically associated with the operation of an office, such as overhead, staff, and equipment. The fee shall be paid in quarterly installments of \$225,000 with the first installment being due immediately upon execution of this agreement; second installment due on June 11th; third installment due September 11th; fourth installment due December 11th; and continuing to be due on a quarterly basis until the termination of the agreement. The Firm will bill its costs quarterly.
