Please note that we will conduct an electronic Townhall on WEDNESDAY, JUNE 7, 2023, at 18:30 EAT. See meeting information below. We will update attendees on the changes to my proposed legislation, the Kenyan proceedings in support of that legislation, US court developments, and the 25th Commemoration. Because of the flurry of recent events, and the anticipated wave of upcoming events through August 7, 2023, it is critical that you attend.

As you should know, through the remarkable leadership of Senator Agnes Kavindu, the Kenyan Senate has before it a proposal to support my proposed legislation in Washington. You can find more information about Senator Kavindu's proposal at [Kenyan Senate Motion Tracker](#).

I was privileged to meet in Nairobi this week with Senator Kavindu, who is and will be a relentless fighter for the victims. I urge you to contact her to express your support for her courageous efforts on behalf of the bombing victims.

I am also pleased to report that Deputy Speaker of the Assembly Gladys Shollei met with me and one of the victims for well over an hour and committed herself to providing support in the Assembly for the proposed Senate action. I am very encouraged to have on our side a legislator of such considerable skill, compassion, and commitment.

With Senator Kavindu, I was also able to spend some time with two other highly respected members of Parliament: Deputy Speaker of the Senate Kathuri Murungi, and Member Sabina Chege. As with Senator Kavindu and Deputy Speaker Shollei, I was impressed with their knowledge and their enthusiastic willingness to help us finally secure our goals,

On May 8, 2023, through the ongoing work of Caroline Muthoka, I met in Washington with Kenyan Senators Joseph Githuku Kamau and Stewart Madzayo. These able and impressive

Senators are in strong support of Senator Kavindu's legislative efforts in support of my proposed American legislation.

These meetings are part of a larger effort directed at both the US Congress and Administration and the Kenyan Parliament and Administration. And are a continuation of efforts which took prominence during the African Leaders Summit in Washington in December 2022.

I urge you therefore to reach out not only to Senator Kavindu but to Deputy Speaker Murungi, Deputy Speaker Shollei, Senators Kamau and Madzayo, and Member Chege, as well as your own Senator and Member. Your appreciation for their support will be an enormously positive influence on their work on your behalf.
