It was an honor meeting you at the Kenyan Embassy on January 30, 2024. Your support for the Kenyan victims of the 1998 Nairobi Embassy bombing was encouraging to the Kenyan victims, including the hundreds that my law firm represents. As you may recall, we have secured \$56.6 billion in judgments, and have proposed budget-neutral U.S. legislation to include those victims in the U.S. Victim Compensation Fund. On March 7, 2024, I was able to meet for an hour with Senator Chris Coons, who has been a staunch friend of Kenya and who now has an interest in our proposal.

I hope this critical matter can be addressed during President Ruto's upcoming March 23, 2024 State visit to Washington, my firm, along with our colleagues at Scribe Strategies & Advisors would be delighted to host a small event for you and your staff if you will be in Washington.
