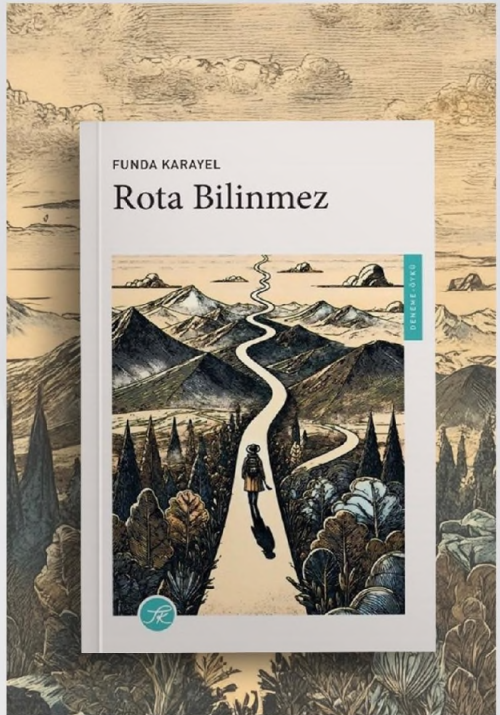

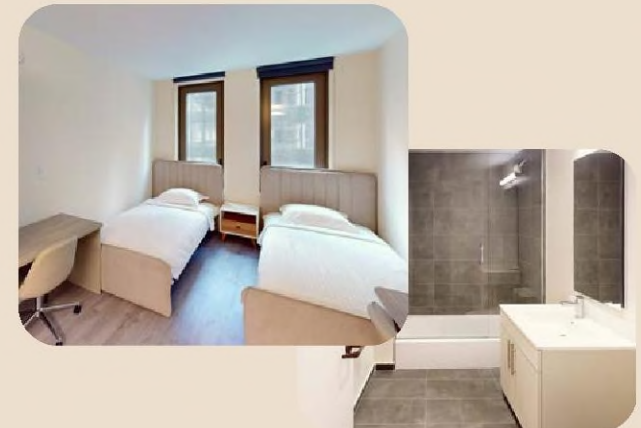
TURKEN HOUSE FEATURES

He is the author of two forthcoming books: *Foreign Intervention and Radicalization in Somalia: How and When Does Conflict Evolve into Violence* (Bloomsbury Publishing, 2025) and *Somalia in Türkiye's Entrepreneurial and Humanitarian Foreign Policy. Instruments and Methods* (Ibn Haldun University Press, 2026). Dr. Alegöz's research focuses on political violence, radicalization, conflict resolution, and the policies of major powers in Africa.
