RE: Congratulations on the ETHIO-SOMALIA agreements.

Dear Honorable PM Abbiy Ahmed,

I hope my letter finds you doing well.

It is my honor to congratulate you on the successful Ethio-Somalian amicable settlements in Ankara, Turkey. It was wise and responsible for the Ethiopian and Somali governments to preserve the peace in the Horn Of Africa region (HOA).

The mischievous regime of Isaias Afewerki in Eritrea has always conducted and embraced any misunderstanding in our region by dowsing petroleum into the burning fire. Instead of acting as a responsible regional player to promote peace, the government of Ethiopia should be isolated by creating new MOUs with Egypt and Somalia to exacerbate the existing tensions.

I am writing to you, Honorable PM Dr. Abbiy Ahmed, as the head of the Ethiopian government, to consider our request to meet with your office on behalf of the Transitional Eritrean Government in exile. I am Ghebre Bahdurai, the organization's president. We have been registered with the State Department of Justice and the National Security Department of the United States of America since August 22, 2022. We work closely with some influential US congressional members willing to champion Eritrean Causes. We are represented by the law firm of the former powerful Congressman Jim Moran from Virginia, USA. The same office would also be interested in representing the federal government of Ethiopia.

We operate and conduct our activities in the US and have members worldwide. One challenge is that Eritreans are fragmented in their journey to free their people from the dictatorial regime of Isaias Afewerki, which included Eritreans living in Ethiopia. Eritrea is nicknamed the North Korea of Africa. According to the famous quote by former Charge de Affair in Eritrea, Steve C Walker, "the Eritrean government of Isaias Aforki can not be dealt with diplomatically." The Transitional Eritrean Government is working diligently to unite the Eritrean people so that we can speak in one unified voice; that is the only way out, and the Ethiopian government can play a crucial role in achieving Eritrean unity.

We have something in common: the regime of Isaias Aforki, in which we are working closely to isolate and force regime change in Eritrea. We work closely with the offices of Congressman Brad Sherman, Congresswoman Betty Mcalom, Congresswoman Marcy Kupter, Congressman Chris Smith, Congressman Cloe of Oklahoma, Congressman John Carter of Texas, and others to champion our Eritrean cause against the Isaias Aforki administrations. Tibor Nagy, former Ambassador to Ethiopia and Undersecretary charged the affair to East Africa, is our spokesperson and advisor to the Eritrean cause. We work closely with the Ambassador, and it is his intention for TEGIE to work with the federal Ethiopian government.

Transitional Eritrean Government In Exile wants to request a meeting with your office sometime in January 2025 to introduce our organization, its purpose, and our people's aspirations to live in democratic Eritrean administrations in peace and harmony.

We appreciate you in advance for considering meeting with us. We are eager to hear from you.
