INTRODUCING THE DIASPORA REGION

The People's National Party took the unprecedented step of permitting membership in the Party to those Jamaicans who live outside of Jamaica. The 84th Annual Party Conference in 2022 ratified a resolution to open membership to Jamaicans who do not reside in Jamaica. This was a long time coming and designed to embrace the many supporters of the PNP who live around the world.

The 85th Annual conference in September, 2023 also expanded the Party's current six regions to include the Diaspora Region. This will give members of the Diaspora an opportunity to serve their Party through membership as well as in leadership and organizational capacities. The Diaspora Region is sub-divided into six zones and each zone is further sub-divided into divisions. Regional, Zone and Division conferences will be held each year where representatives to the Party's National Executive Council (NEC) will be chosen.

Jamaica quickly regained the confidence of the international community and signed an Extended Fund Facility with the IMF in 2013. With this, Jamaica was able to pass nine consecutive quarterly reviews and was able to re-enter global capital markets and secure the lowest interest rates ever.

- A. Jamaica became increasingly attractive to both local and foreign investors.
- B. The debt to GDP ratio was reduced.
- C. Our Net International Reserves increased to \$1.91 billion in 2015.

- D. Inflation was significantly reduced from 9.5% in 2013 to 6.4% in 2014/15.
- E. Jamaica moved up in the Global Competitiveness Index and ranked 64 out of 146 nations in the 2014 Forbes Best Countries for Business Report.

- F. The PNP reopened all the sources of credit that had virtually dried up under the JLP.
- G. The World Bank's Doing Business 2015 report showed an improvement in Jamaica's ranking.
- H. Jamaican businesses benefited from the lowest interest rates in decades.
