



We are excited to have the opportunity to work with you and the National Salvation Front (hereafter referred to as "NAS") technical team. This Letter of Agreement sets forth the parameters of the business relationship between Moran Global Strategies Inc. (hereafter referred to as "MGS"), and NAS.

Scope of Representation

This Agreement represents a bilateral contract which if signed and returned to MGS will establish a contract between MGS and NAS. We will devote our best efforts to representing NAS and in doing so we will adhere strictly to both the legal and ethical obligations of our profession. Moran Global Strategies will provide the following services over this six-month engagement:

- Legislative and Executive Branch Stakeholders: Coordinate meetings with and outreach to members of the Senate Foreign Relations and House Foreign Affairs Committees (including relevant subcommittees and staff), as well as senior U.S. government officials and relevant executive branch personnel.
- Policy Advocacy & Narrative Development: Shape discussions within Washington, D.C., policy and media circles to ensure NAS's federalist and democratic agenda is accurately represented and prioritized.
- Stakeholder Coordination: Engage with prominent think tanks, policy institutions, civil society organizations, and relevant stakeholders focused on governance, human rights, and long-term stabilization.

- Preparation for visit by the Chairman and Commander-in-Chief of NAS: Engage with the NAS Technical Team to meet stakeholders in Washington (legislative and executive), paving the way for a visit by the Chairman and Commander-in-Chief of the National Salvation Front.

MGS and NAS agree to comply with all applicable laws, including those under the Lobbying Disclosure Act (LDA), as amended, the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA) as amended, and any regulations and/or rules promulgated thereunder. MGS acknowledges and understands that MGS will be solely responsible for its own compliance with all registration and reporting obligations imposed by FARA on MGS in connection with the services performed under this Agreement.

#### Fees and Expenses and Term of Engagement

Subject to the terms of this paragraph, NAS will pay MGS a monthly retainer fee of US\$12,000. The term of this Agreement is September 1, 2025, until February 28, 2026, with monthly fees billed in advance on the first of the month and due on or before the 15th day of each calendar month. All payments shall be preceded by an invoice from MGS. This contract may be terminated with 30 days of notice provided on the first of the month prior to termination.

In addition, NAS will reimburse MGS for reasonable and necessary out-of-pocket items that MGS receives prior authorization for, and that exceed, \$1,000.00. Administrative costs (phone, nominal travel, administrative support) are included in the retainer.

This Agreement will become effective upon signatures from both parties.

#### Conflicts

MGS represents that this engagement will not represent a conflict of interest or otherwise conflict with our faithful representation of NAS under this Agreement. MGS shall promptly disclose any actual or apparent conflicts of interest that arise in the course of any engagement undertaken by MGS.

#### Independent Contractor

The Parties acknowledge awareness and stated preference that this is an agreement for services as an independent contractor. The Parties will exert all manner of good faith and take all reasonable efforts to ensure performance and prevent repudiation by other parties connected with its activities which could affect its performance under this Agreement. Furthermore, as an independent contractor, MGS shall not be held liable for any breach or failure to perform under subsequent contracts entered into between NAS and any third Party.

Confidentiality

MGS agrees that all documents, information or communications (whether verbal or recorded) exchanged with NAS (including NAS's officers, employees, contractors, or attorneys), and any information generated or received by MGS in the course of performance of this engagement, are confidential, and will not be disclosed by MGS to any person except as authorized by NAS or as required by law. MGS agrees not to use any confidential information for any purpose other than performance of this engagement.

This provision shall survive expiration or termination of this engagement.

General Provisions

- a) No modification or waiver of this Agreement shall be binding unless in writing and signed by the parties hereto.
- b) Severability. If one or more of the provisions in this Agreement are deemed void by law, then the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.
- c) This Agreement, and all transactions contemplated hereby, shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the United States of America.
- d) Any dispute arising under, related to or concerning this Agreement shall be litigated exclusively in federal or state court of competent jurisdiction that is situated in the Commonwealth of Virginia. In the event any legal action is necessary to enforce this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be able to recover any and all reasonable attorney fees and costs necessary to enforce this Agreement.
- e) During the term of this agreement and at all times thereafter, MGS shall not disclose confidential information related to NAS or to third parties, nor use confidential information for any purpose whatsoever except for the purpose of performing services on behalf of NAS.
- f) MGS shall have sole responsibility for payment of all federal, State, and local taxes or contributions imposed or required under unemployment insurance, workmen's compensation, Social Security, and income tax laws and for filing all required tax forms with respect to any amounts paid by NAS hereunder and any amounts paid by MGS to its employees. MGS shall indemnify and hold NAS harmless against any claims or liability (including penalties) resulting from failure of MGS to pay such taxes or contributions, or failure of MGS to file any such tax forms.
