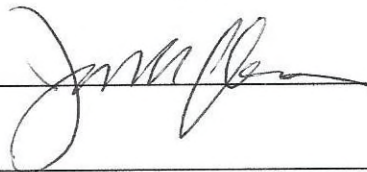

Idrissa Seck, founder and present leader of the Rewmi Party, a Senegalese Political Party, and announced candidate for President of Senegal	(1) I arranged an engagement between Mr. Seck and U.S. entity "Vanguard Africa." Two principals in Vanguard, Jeffrey Smith and Bruce Fryer, both U.S. citizens, filed FARA Short Term Registrations Statements on May 25, 2023 with Vanguard as the primary registrant (FARA Registration # 6411). I first met with Mr. Smith and Mr. Fryer on April 24, 2023 in Washington D.C. The engagement terms between Mr. Seck and Vanguard are listed in the May 25, 2023 Registration Statements. The terms include FARA political activity to be conducted by Vanguard in behalf of Mr. Seck. Following the engagement between Mr. Seck and Vanguard, I did not engage in further FARA political activity in behalf of Mr. Seck. I did confer internally with Vanguard on some of its political activity in behalf of Mr. Seck, but I made no communications with others regarding these activities. The political activities are disclosed in the FARA filings of Vanguard, Mr. Smith and Mr. Fryer during the reporting period for this Supplemental Statement. (2) Prior to the engagement of Vanguard by Mr. Seck, on April 18, 2023, I sent an email to Julian Pecquet, a reporter for "The Africa Report" (published by "Jeune Afrique," a French news periodical). The email was responsive to his contacting me after he saw my original FARA filing regarding Mr. Seck of April 10, 2023. The email attached a Statement by me. I have filed with FARA a copy of my email and Statement to Mr. Pecquet as Informational Material." I do not know if my Statement was further disseminated. (3) During the reporting period, I gave advice to Mr. Seck as his attorney on his political and business activities within the country of Senegal. More specifically, the advice concerned his candidacy for President of Senegal and one of his businesses, which was the start-up of a school in Senegal, "Lycee Numerique." The school provides promising Senegalese high school students with advanced education in math and science to prepare them for entry in top technical universities in the U.S. and Europe. The goal is for the students to return to Senegal for their professional careers. On May 16, 2023, I with others involved in the school, met in Dakar with Senegalese government officials concerning the school.
