Republic of Honduras	The Registrant provided strategic advice, policy consultancy for the purpose of strengthening relations between the Government of the Republic of Honduras and the Government of the United States of America. The Registrant working closely with the Washington-based law firm Arnold and Porter made representations with legislative and executive branches of the U.S. government for the purposes of bolstering bilateral ties, including promoting a greater appreciation of the strategic value of the U.S. alliance with Honduras, as well as advocating for greater cooperation on immigration, the fight against drug trafficking cartels, and expanded trade, investment and financial ties between the United States and Honduras. The strategic and policy advice the registrant provided officials of the Government of Honduras equally related to diplomatic approaches with the U.S. Administration and the U.S. Congress on the core issues of immigration, counter narcotics, anti-corruption, trade, investment, financial, and security issues.

Response to Item 12-Description

Republic of Honduras: The Registrant rendered advice to the Foreign Principal with the objective of strengthening bilateral ties between the Government of the Republic of Honduras and the Government of the United States of America. Among the many activities included providing strategic advice to the Government of the Republic of Honduras and the law firm Arnold and Porter on seeking a greater appreciation by the Government of the United States of America of the value of its alliance with the Republic of Honduras. The Registrant advocated, as necessary, with U.S. executive and legislative branch officials for closer cooperation between the two governments in the areas of migration, military-to-military, combatting drug trafficking cartels, as well as enhancing trade, investment and financial links between the United States and the Republic of Honduras.
