Hi Patrick,

Thanks again for taking the time to meet with us to discuss the Agility issue. Below is the draft language for consideration. Please let us know if you have any edits or additions so we can get the committees approval on the language and lock in bipartisan sponsors.

Draft language

The Committee is concerned that telecommunications equipment developed or manufactured by Huawei have been deployed to the Middle East region, more specifically Iraq. Given the U.S.'s support to the region, any use of Huawei equipment could pose a serious security risk to national and foreign interests. Therefore, the Committee directs the Secretary of Defense to submit a briefing to the House Armed Services Committee no later than December 31, 2025 that includes an assessment of Huawei equipment deployed in Iraq. The briefing shall identify:

- 1. Any foreign agencies, departments, and individuals responsible for approving the deployment;*
- 2. Any risk posed to U.S. assets in the region;*
- 3. Any risk to classified and unclassified DOD systems;*
- 4. Any risk to military personnel's personally identifiable information.*
