Statement from Counsel for Eduard Khudainatov and Millemarin Investments Ltd.*The following can be attributed to Adam Ford, counsel for the claimants:*

We respectfully disagree with the Court's decision to grant the government's motion to strike our clients' claim on standing. The ruling is both legally and factually flawed, and we are confident it will not withstand appellate review.

The Court misapplied the law governing standing in forfeiture proceedings, disregarding well-established principles that protect the rights of claimants in such cases. Moreover, the Court improperly relied on speculative and unreliable assertions from the government while failing to give due weight to the extensive evidence we presented in support of our claim.

We will pursue all available appellate remedies and remain steadfast in our commitment to ensuring that our clients' legal rights are fully vindicated.
