

General Explanation: The objective of the agreement was to prevent the same perception of the 2018 elections being applied to the 2023 elections. Although never proved and without substantiated evidence the claim was spread that the second-place finisher won the election with close to fifty percent of the vote. The same or similar groups did their best to discredit the 2023 election despite the fact that President Felix Tshisekedi was committed to running a free and fair election on the schedule required by Congolese law. The Congolese National Election Commission (CENI) was in charge of managing the election and met all the requirements for running a free and fair election. MTL's specific aim was to respond to concerns expressed by Senator Chris Coons and Chairperson Michael McCaul in a letter to the President of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Felix Tshisekedi, dated November 7th. We responded in meetings with Congressional staff. Meetings were held on December 13 with Mark Milosch (Congressman Smith), December 14th Tanner Brown (Congressperson James J. Baird), December 14th Trisha Hamilton (Congressperson Jonathan Jackson), and December 19th Elizabeth Mount (House Foreign Affairs Committee in Foreign Affairs (John James). In addition, during this period, a meeting and two or telephone calls were held with Chris Kulukundis (House Foreign Affairs Committee).
