### **LEIDAR USA INC WORK SCOPE FOR BENI ADAM INC, MUSLIM WORLD LEAGUE DELEGATION VISIT TO U.S.**

#### Background

- Beni Adam and Muslim World League, two organizations with substantially shared objectives including promotion of the Principles of the Charter of Makkah, have agreed to work together to plan and execute events and messaging relating to a delegation from the Muslim World League (including His Excellency Sheikh Al-Issa) to the United States in January 2024 (“MWL Delegation”). As part of their agreement, they agreed that Beni Adam would, as part of their arrangement, engage Leidar to provide services in support of the MWL Delegation.

#### Project Scope

- Leidar will support the staff of Beni Adam and Muslim World League before, during and following the visit of His Excellency Sheikh Al-Issa and the MWL Delegation in January 2024 with planning, strategy, logistics, messaging, and communications.

#### Project Term

- This project scope is effective December 26, 2023 through January 31, 2024.

#### Project Goals

- Position Sheikh Al-Issa in the U.S. as an independent, transformative religious leader who can help foster interfaith cooperation among U.S. religious and social institutions and be an outspoken advocate for the anti-hate movement, per the Principles of the Charter of Makkah.
- Affirm and grow Sheikh Al-Issa’s position as a leader of the Muslim ummah in the US and strengthen the Muslim World League brand with US based media and other stakeholders.
- Support the efforts of the Anti-Hate Coalition of Religious Leaders with US opinion leaders.

#### Actions and Deliverables

- Plan and execute meetings for Sheikh Al-Issa with religious organizations and philanthropic leaders who support peaceful humanitarian aid to Gaza.



- Plan and implement a discussion forum sponsored and hosted by the Council on Foreign Relations featuring His Excellency and other interfaith leaders.
- Reach out to Muslim Chaplains at the top US universities and within the US military to schedule meetings and informational listening sessions, and plan and execute these meetings.
- Establish a dialogue with victims of recent hate crimes (e.g. Vermont, Detroit) so His Excellency can show his empathy and compassion and speak out on the importance of stopping anti-Semitism and Islamaphobia.
- Research and find opportunities for meetings with policy makers to discuss the impact of anti-Semitism and Islamaphobia, and solutions to be implemented by community leaders to combat the growing problem.
- Conduct research and develop appropriate messaging for Sheikh Al-Issa when meeting with different audiences and talking about the critical issues. Build message narratives and contribute to talking points, statements, and other public communications during the visit.
- Conduct outreach and engage selected news outlets in Washington and New York, including Time Magazine, to conduct interviews with His Excellency.

Project Budget

- Fixed fee budget for the project duration of \$50,000 payable in two installmens as follows: (1) \$25,000 prior to commencement of work, and (2) \$25,000 on January 31, 2024 upon completion of work.
- Budget is inclusive of standard out of pocket expenses (travel, lodging and meals).
- Any paid media, sponsorship fees or advertising cost will be incremental and separate from the project fees. No expenses whatsoever shall be borne by the client unless pre-approved by the latter in writing.
