Steven Paul Weber is a missionary, Christian minister and international public figure, president of Steve Weber International. For 29 years (from 1991 to 2020) he headed the CBN (Christian Broadcasting Network) division in the CIS countries and Eastern Europe. One of the founders of the "Ukraine without Orphans" Alliance, the "Territory of Responsibility" movement, and the "Outback Ukraine" project.

Steve Weber took his first independent steps in missionary service as a teenager. In the early 1980s, having discovered his calling to serve the peoples of the former USSR, Steve Weber made several missionary trips to Russia and Ukraine, where he intensively studied the Russian language and Slavic culture. In 1991, he joined the CBN initiative and led an evangelistic media blitz that received millions of letters from all over the former Soviet Union. People wrote about their need for the love of Jesus Christ.

Steve Weber is an activist in the international adoption movement. Steve and Christy Weber are the parents of six children, three of whom are adopted.

Over the years of his service to God and people, Steve Weber has started, supported and developed dozens of media and social initiatives. These are projects aimed at reaching people with the Gospel, strengthening families, combating orphanhood and restoring human integrity according to God's plan.

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Hopefully, both of these opportunities will provide you a chance to go deeper in your understanding on the situation in Ukraine. Of course, I welcome your thoughts and hope that everything is great in your world.

Wes,

Thank you so much for making the time for me today. I see I missed a call from Jeff Anderson as well, whom I had the pleasure of meeting earlier this week. Obviously, I've learned much more about your ministry this week and I'm so impressed with the vision of Pulse. I pray God will bless your ministry with growth in global abundance.

My client is Kyiv Global Outreach, an organization that is funding the Defenders of Faith and Religious Freedom in Ukraine project. This project is dedicated to defending the right of Ukrainians to peacefully practice Christianity in their chosen house of worship and to advocate for the defense of religious freedom from Russian aggression in Ukraine.

As we discussed, what I proposed was the following:

1. Amplify would add a Ukrainian band to the festival performance rotation. We will determine the equipment needs by COB on Tuesday, June 11th.
2. Amplify would allow a 60-90 second video to introduce the band. No political messaging just an introduction of the band, short message on Christian persecution, and a closing request to pray for Ukraine.
3. KGO would arrange for a reporter to embed into the weekend and produce a story on Amplify and their European outreach.
4. KGO would provide a sponsorship at the \$5,000 level and occupy a booth during the weekend with literature on the plight of Christians in Ukraine.
5. KGO would request an opportunity for Nick Hall to minister in Ukraine sometime in 2024 - his schedule permitting.

My vision for this is to connect Amplify with an international audience and use that moment to bring hope to those in Ukraine that need it. We would like to lock this plan in so we can begin working on a friendly reporter, locking down the band logistics, and making sure everything runs as smooth as possible.
