


As described in the attached engagement letter, CapConn, LLC was engaged for the period of May 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022, to help support the passage of of AB 2273, which established an age-appropriate design code, instituting online protections for children 17 and under. The registrant registered on behalf of the foreign principal pursuant to California lobbying law on April 19, 2022 and held several meetings with officials before the May 1 effective date. It also sent one email after the termination date to seek a signed copy of the bill. The registrant is no longer providing services to the foreign principal.




Capitol Connection will be pleased to provide government affairs services on behalf of the 5Rights Foundation (client) during the period of May 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022. It is anticipated by Capitol Connection that the essential elements of services to be rendered would be as follows:

- Provide Sacramento based strategic consulting and legislative advocacy services in support of AB 2273 (Wicks), 5Rights Foundation's priority measure to establish an age-appropriate design code in California. Work in support of the measure may, include:
 - Regular participation on coalition coordination calls
 - Direct lobbying on the measure
 - Letter development and review
 - Review and negotiation on amendments proposed by stakeholders

Capitol Connection, a California corporation, will be considered an independent contractor in providing all services to the client. This agreement shall commence on May 1, 2022 and shall continue through September 30, 2022, unless modified by mutual agreement or terminated pursuant to the terms of this agreement.

Client agrees to pay Capitol Connection for identified services rendered during the period of this agreement a fee of ten thousand dollars per month. Invoices will be sent at the end of each month in covered by this agreement.

Payments received by Capitol Connection after the 30th day of the following month shall be subject to a five (5) percent late fee plus interest at the rate of one-and-one-half (1.5) percent per month on the remaining balance.

Client agrees to reimburse Capitol Connection upon presentation of itemized statements for expenses incurred for the cost of printing, reproduction, postage, overnight express mailing services and travel expenses incurred to attend client requested meetings scheduled outside of Sacramento County, California, as well as any other reasonable expenses approved in advance by the client. Client agrees that no travel outside of Sacramento will be required while the California Legislature is in session.

All other expenses incurred by Capitol Connection in the execution of this Agreement, including but not limited to preparing strategy, resolving technical issues, or meeting with interested parties within Sacramento County, shall be borne by Capitol Connection.

The work product of Capitol Connection shall mean any and all tangible products, data, reports, information recorded by whatever means, documents, written materials, and any and all other work products, or any portion thereof, including drafts, prepared, generated or provided by Capitol Connection in connection with performance of the consulting services to be provided pursuant to this Agreement (“Work Product”). All Work Product shall be the sole property of the client. Capitol Connection hereby assigns to the client all rights, title and interest in any and all Work Product, including any and all copyright ownership rights in such Work Product.
