Appendix Response to Item 5

Item 5: Each item checked above must be explained below in full detail together with, where appropriate, specific reference to and identity of the item in the registration statement to which it pertains.

Pursuant to the FARA Unit's July 15 and July 25, 2024 letters, as well as a telephone conversation with the FARA Unit on July 29 and a subsequent email on July 31, Invest India hereby amends Exhibit B to its initial registration. Accordingly, Item 6 is revised to be checked. Invest India revises Item 7 to read July 12, 2023 (the date on which Ms. Rai jointed Invest India). Item 8 is revised to read as follows.

The Foreign Principal and Registrant in this case are the same - both are Invest India. Invest India does not have a separately incorporated U.S. entity that could otherwise serve as the Registrant. Ms. Nivruti Rai, the Managing Director and CEO, serves as the "responsible individual" noted in Item 5(c) of Invest India's Registration Statement, and has filed a Short Form Registration Statement along with two other individuals working on Invest India's behalf.

Invest India hereby provides a complete description of the terms and conditions of Ms. Rai's employment agreement with Invest India, including its duration and fees and expenses.

Invest India sent an appointment Letter to Ms. Rai on June 19, 2023 to serve as Invest India's CEO and Managing Director, and Ms. Rai joined Invest India on July 12, 2023. The duration of the employment agreement is a period of three years, which can be extended further subject to review and approval by the Board of Invest India. Ms. Rai works for Invest India on a full-time basis. In this role she is responsible for the internal administrative activities and functions required to manage the day-to-day affairs of Invest India under the supervision of the Board of Directors. Her responsibilities are global in scope. Pursuant to this agreement, Ms. Rai is paid a consolidated remuneration of INR 8,500,000 per year, or approximately USD \$102,410.00 per year. In addition, Invest India also provides Ms. Rai with living expenses in India, including housing, transportation, and communication costs. Further, Invest India bears all expenses incurred in furtherance of activities undertaken by her in the United States on behalf of Invest India, and Invest India either pays these expenses directly or through a corporate credit card and reimburses the expenses incurred by her for undertaking official activities on its behalf. These expenses include costs for travel to, from, and within the United States for Invest India business; lodging and meals while in the United States; and other incidental business costs.
