Double-Edged Sword: How we can leverage advanced technology for the global good and – crucially – why we must avoid getting this wrong.

Richard Attias has long been advocating for increased adoption of AI and the need for targeted investments in advanced technologies to address major global challenges, including access to healthcare and education and tackling and mitigating the impact of climate change. This is especially important for the global south – which is a key focus of Richard’s work. However, while we can all agree that these new technologies, especially AI, present huge opportunities, they also bring significant risks, and with the wrong approach to issues like investment, regulation and integration, there is a risk that global inequalities will be exacerbated. Richard’s experience and current role at the nexus of business, financial services and politics enables him to take a truly holistic and global view and approach when examining these challenges and opportunities, including possible solutions.
