Hi [REDACTED] – great chatting earlier...I mentioned to [REDACTED] I've asked about Richard's ability to move up the interview – as soon as I get word one way or the other I will let you both know.

[Here is the FII Institute's PRIORITY Compass 2024 report I mentioned](#), which is in its third iteration. I think you'll agree these statistics serve as a compelling to action for global leaders to invest in targeted technologies and collaboration across borders to create a more connected and in-sync effort.

There were a few stark differences from last year, painting a disappointing picture in several core areas including world satisfaction, political stability, healthcare access and technological preparedness:

- There is an **11% decline in citizens' satisfaction with the state of world affairs from 2023-2024**, with over half of respondents indicating they are dissatisfied with the situation in the world.
- This is further compounded by a **majority of respondents (71%) stating dissatisfaction with the level of corruption in their country**, with the global north reporting more dissatisfaction than the global south.
- **Cost of living and quality of life topped the charts as the #1 concern for global respondents (40%)** compared to only 19% for the next highest category, governance.
- **Less than half of respondents stated they feel their country is prepared for the digital age**, and there is a clear gap between the global south (57%) versus the global north (35%).
- **Healthcare ranks as the number three concern**, with affordability and access to doctors cited as top issues.
- Despite perceived concern about the environment worldwide, **environmental concern is the top issue for only 13% of respondents**, only scoring as the top concern in India.
