Shift to the South: The investment case for a region overlooked
Global attention has shifted away from the global south, including Africa and poorer South American and Asian countries. Alongside this, many better-developed South American countries – especially Argentina – are experiencing some very significant economic challenges, limiting their ability to support poorer countries in their region. Several Western countries

have also cut their aid budgets in the last ten years, including the US and UK, the two biggest donors of international aid. In this context, Richard Attias can elaborate why it's crucial we don't forget about our collective mission and responsibility to level up the global south, discussing how the global community can harness private capital investment – including from Western nations and the Middle East. He can also explore the sectors for prioritization, including sustainability given COP and the G20 are both being held in South America, in order to achieve meaningful change.

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AI's Double-Edged Sword: The challenges and opportunities of advanced technology

Richard Attias has long considered the implications of increased adoption of AI and the need for targeted investments in advanced technologies to address bottlenecks in healthcare, education and the climate crisis. He can discuss challenges and solutions of ethical and sustainable AI integration given the multi-faceted nuances of the AI explosion – a double-edged sword for humanity. He and other panelists (or as moderator) could delve into:

- Using AI in developing countries, specifically in the global south to address the lack of healthcare professionals, educators and frontline workers
- How the fragmented regulatory environment had made AI integration challenging on a global scale and what the future intersection of policy and progress may look like
- The various cultural divides that put stress on universal technology, specifically in language-based AI programs

Adapting for a future of equitable health against evolving threats

Richard can discuss the evolving landscape of global healthcare in a post-COVID world, sharing insights from his work with heads of state and global leaders to devise and pursue innovative, bold and often disruptive solutions. Fueled by proprietary data collected to assess the readiness and vulnerability of communities to handle emerging pandemic and health system threats, Richard can speak to:

- How to best leverage new applications of technology, such as AI and robotics, and research to improve health equity
- Strategies to address key issues like vaccine apartheid, particularly amid concerns of the bird flu and other pandemics
- Opportunities to unlock greater innovation in sanitation infrastructure for global health, including through private-public partnerships
- Emerging diseases caused by climate change
- The need for policies that consider both human health and the wellbeing of the planet's animals and ecosystems

Fueling the Future: The intersection of policy and investment to fuel energy innovation

To address the growing climate crises there must be a meaningful intersection of policy, investment, innovation and global community to drive lasting change. Richard can discuss the opportunities for technology-driven solutions that reduce greenhouse gasses, secure sustainable food supply chains and manage the impact of climate change with alternative energy sources. Other topics may include:

- Differentiating investments beyond decarbonization which makes up over 90% of current climate finance initiatives despite the slow movement towards Net Zero. These differentiated investments could include relocating and retrofitting infrastructure and other adaptation techniques as technology progresses.
- How companies can pursue technology-driven projects, such as world mapping (which creates geometric representations of entire languages through machine learning techniques) to enable a smooth energy transition and sustainable future
- Why the collective momentum and demand for change across companies, investors and citizens has yet to be leveraged at scale (estimates put green share of global stimulus between .2-.4%)
