Subject: Conversation with Richard Attias, FII Chairman?

I have been looking at some of your recent coverage unpacking how global platforms rewired entire industries and wanted to offer a source that might be of interest.

[Richard Attias](#), Chairman of the FII Institute Executive Committee, has rewired the convening industry, reshaping how global deals get done in an era when the world's most influential gatherings are no longer confined to a single mountain town, but span the globe, truly integrating the East and West.

In a world increasingly defined by who gets a seat at the table, Richard Attias chose a different path: he created the table himself. He gathers global CEOs, business executives and policymakers to discuss the most pressing advancements around technology, education, healthcare and sustainability today.

Attias orchestrates summits that shape narratives as much as they foster meaningful capital allocation. Last year's iteration of his hallmark conference, FII8, [resulted](#) in more than 30 deals made, totaling \$70 billion in value.

As FII's Summits span from Riyadh to Rio de Janeiro, Miami to Tirana, Attias has become a global architect against the background of decentralized global discourse. His career similarly stretches the spectrum, from his Moroccan roots to the heart of international influence. He could be a really interesting subject for one of your profile pieces.
