Following up as now might be a good time for [REDACTED] to sit down with Richard right after the FII9 Conference in Riyadh. Know the podcast tends to focus on big economic and policy trends, which were certainly front and center at FII9, especially as they related to global fragmentation so that might be an avenue for them to explore.

At this year's conference, one theme really emerged: the world isn't fragmenting, it's rewiring with capital and partnerships re-routing toward emerging regions. Ricard could speak to examples of how this is happening in practice on a global scale in the context of:

- Geographies where direct foreign investment is reshaping the investment landscape.
- How new forms of global cooperation are emerging as nations de-risk supply chains without retreating from globalization.
- Why energy security & AI infrastructure are now the key drivers of capital clustering in the Gulf, India and Asia.
- How de-risking can become the new macro framework for globalization, and what that means for investment flows.

Know we were in touch a bit ago about a potential conversation with Richard Attias from Future Investment Initiative Institute and wanted to follow up as now might be a good time to sit down with him following the 9th edition of the conference (FII9) in Riyadh.

Conversations at FII9 largely circled the idea of sustainable investing, especially in light of concerns around AI/data center growth, massive energy demand and emerging markets' infrastructure. Namely, at the conference, ACWA Power announced the signing of a series of landmark agreements with a combined value USD 10 billion, covering multiple regions and encompassing financing partnerships, renewable energy, and storage projects, as well as collaboration in research and technology development. Richard could elaborate more on concepts like:

- **The Energy Trilemma:** The call for balancing speed, scale, and resilience in the transition, emphasizing digital grids, flexible renewables and the need to achieve affordable, reliable, and sustainable power.
- **Investment in Sustainable Infrastructure:** Investment to enable developing nations' shift to clean power, and advocacy for global financing of the renewable transition.
- **Emerging Hubs of Sustainability:** How FII9 conversations pointed to the Gulf region, parts of Africa, Guyana, China, Turkey and Latin America as the next wave of sustainability hubs: where capital is lining up behind grids, clean generation, and human-capital infrastructure

Would you be open to arranging a conversation with Richard to unpack these dynamics for a piece in Moral Money? Might be a good opportunity to show how foreign direct investment is reshaping the sustainable investment landscape.
