

7. DATE OF THE MANDATE: 07/02/2024
8. NATURE OF THE MANDATE: To introduce the GBBDC project to the DFC with a view to establish its eligibility for potential funding and in that event to assist the Principal in clearly presenting materials to DFC to accurately represent the project in its essential details, ownership structure, economic and social impact and its financial structure and needs.
9. NATURE OF ACTIVITIES: The mandate was read as being narrow in scope and did not extend into the area of lobbying or widespread dissemination of materials. During the period in question all interchange of information was by email (with one or two phone calls) and there were no face-to-face meetings between the registrant, the Principals nor the DFC.
10. NATURE OF POLITICAL ACTIVITIES: These included only the delivery of descriptive materials to the DFC, sufficient for the agency to make a determination regarding the project's eligibility. There was no lobbying nor advertising nor other dissemination of materials.

Since filing my registration under FARA on August 8, 2024 the activities in which the registrant has been engaged included periodic contact with both the Zimbabwe Principals and the DFC in Washington DC and two instances of interaction with the press. He conducted no lobbying-type activities but has been passively awaiting a decision from the DFC as to the general eligibility of the GBBDC project to be considered for DFC funding. Between August 8 and September 4, 2024 he made periodic contact with the staff of DFC (Ms. Rashanda Johnson, Director of Business Development), to ascertain the status of the decision as to eligibility. In the final week of August he asked if it would be possible to attend a meeting with Ms. Johnson to discuss the status of the project and she set up a virtual meeting for Tuesday September 3. It was during that virtual meeting that Ms Johnson conveyed to the registrant that DFC would not be moving forward with the GBBDC project. That news was immediately transmitted to the Zimbabwe Principals. The following day, September 4, the registrant followed up with some suggested further actions that might be considered in exploring whether that decision might be reversible. That same day the Principals replied saying that they did not want to take any further action in furtherance of the project. The registrant replied the same day (September 4) confirming that the representative relationship had ended.
