Consulting Agreement

This Consulting Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of 22 March 2025, by and between:

Razom We Stand ("Client")
and
Ilya Zaslavskiy ("Consultant")

Whereas:

A. The Client intends to engage the Consultant to support the organization and execution of key advocacy and stakeholder engagement activities in Washington DC, Brussels, and London.

B. The Consultant possesses the requisite skills, expertise, and network to provide the specified services.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. Background and Objectives

1.1 Background:

The objective of this engagement is to support the Client in facilitating key meetings and events related to advocacy efforts in Washington DC, Brussels, and London. The Consultant will provide logistical, organizational, and advisory support to ensure successful convenings with policymakers, NGOs, and other relevant stakeholders.

1.2 Objectives:

The Consultant shall:

- Proactively organize the convening of a meeting of NGOs in Washington DC at the end of April in coordination with B4U.
- Organize and attend meetings for SR in Washington DC with key stakeholders at the end of April.
- Help Lera in organizing a Brussels event with the Polish Presidency on LNG and RePower EU.
- Schedule meetings for SR with Chatham House and IDS in London in March.
- Organize and attend meetings with contacts and policymakers in Washington DC as appropriate.

2. Scope of Work

The Consultant will:

- Coordinate logistics for planned meetings and events.
- Engage with relevant stakeholders to schedule and confirm participation.
- Provide strategic advice on engagement approaches with policymakers and organizations.
- Attend meetings as required and provide post-meeting reports or summaries to the Client.

3. Deliverables

The Consultant is expected to deliver:

- A schedule of confirmed meetings and events for Washington DC, Brussels, and London.
 - Coordination support for event logistics and stakeholder participation.
 - Summary reports of key meetings attended.

4. Timeline

This Agreement shall commence on 22 March 2025 and shall remain in effect until 22 of April 2025, unless terminated earlier as per Section 8.

5. Contractor Payments

5.1 In consideration of the Services provided by the Consultant, the Client will pay the Consultant a monthly payment of £5,895.17. From this amount, any applicable deductions for benefits, in accordance with the Client's internal policies and the corresponding percentage rates, will be applied prior to disbursement.

5.2 If the Consultant is unable to carry out the Services due to illness or accident or is unavailable for any other reason, they will not be entitled to receive any CPs in respect of the period of inability or unavailability.

5.4 The CPs may be changed by mutual agreement of the parties in writing.

6. Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)

Given the sensitivity of the work, the Consultant agrees to maintain strict confidentiality of all information received or developed during the course of this engagement. Any sharing of information must be authorized in writing by the Client.

7. Copyright

7.1 Any materials, reports, or deliverables developed by the Consultant under this Agreement shall be the exclusive property of Razom We Stand.

7.2 The Consultant retains the right to include non-confidential portions of the work in their portfolio, provided that proprietary or sensitive information is excluded and proper credit is given to Razom We Stand.

8. Termination

8.1 Either party may terminate this Agreement with 10 days' prior written notice.

8.2 In the event of termination, the Consultant shall be compensated for all work completed up to the date of termination, subject to any applicable penalties.

8.3 If either party materially breaches this Agreement, the other party may terminate it immediately if the breach is not remedied within 7 days of written notice.

9. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

10. Penalty Clause

10.1 In the event that any deliverable is not provided within the agreed timeline, the Consultant shall incur a penalty amounting to 2% of the total compensation, payable to Razom We Stand.

10.2 If the Consultant breaches any copyright, sharing, or confidentiality obligations, they shall be subject to legal action and a penalty of no less than two times the value of the work performed.
