Dear Ambassador,

Our team is looking forward to moving forward with political support for the government of Somalia in both the form of government and public relations functions.

Parties: This agreement is effective upon execution and is made by and between Arsenal Government and Public Affairs Group (AGPAG) and the Embassy of Somalia. (Client).

Scope of Work: On behalf of the Client, AGPAG will provide government and public affairs services concerning U.S. / Somali and greater international relations.

AGPAG Team: AGPAG may assign nascent team members to tasks under the agreement from time to time, but the campaign will be primarily led by Iraq War Veteran and Chief Executive Officer Christopher Neiweem and Political Expert, adviser, and campaign-co leader Roger Stone Jr.

Neiweem will be the main point of contact for the Ambassador and government of Somalia.

Fees and Term In consideration for AGPAG's services, the client agrees to pay AGPAG a monthly professional fee of \$44,000 for 12 months beginning September 9, 2025 and ending October 31, 2026. Payment will be made quarterly in advance.

AGPAG will also be paid for ordinary and reasonable out of pocket expenses.

Invoicing: Fees and expenses will be transmitted separately.

A: Professional fees: An invoice for AGPAG's first payment for services provided from September 9, 2025 to October 31, 2026 is attached and due upon execution of the agreement. Hereafter, AGPAG will invoice clients on the first day of each quarter.

B: Expenses: AGPAG will submit invoices for expenses at the end of each month.

Legal Compliance: AGPAG will comply with all federal and state laws, regulations and orders applicable to services performed without limitation to the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act of 1977, 15 USC, and all requirements under the Foreign Agent Registration Act (FARA). We will post all required filings with the DOJ Fara unit per standard reporting requirements.

Indemnification: The Client agrees that neither AGPAG or any of its consultants or employees or representatives shall have any liability to the Client its employees or directors or consultants for any damages arising out of or related to AGPAG's services under this agreement, except to the extent that such damages result from AGPAG's breach of its obligations or commit an unlawful act.

Client agrees to indemnify AGPAG against all claims and legal expenses related to this contract and its accompanying services.

Termination: Either party may cancel or terminate this agreement at its discretion with or without cause upon giving the other party no less than 90 days written notice.

Confidentiality: Except as set out below, "Confidential Information" means all non-public, confidential, or proprietary information disclosed before, on or after the date of this agreement, by either party (a "Disclosing Party") to the other Party (a "Recipient") or its affiliates, or to any of such Recipient's or its affiliates' employees, officers, directors, partners, shareholders, agents, attorneys, accountants, or advisors (collectively, "Representatives"), whether disclosed orally or disclosed or accessed in written, electronic, or other form or media, and whether or not marked, designated, or otherwise identified as "confidential,"

Except as required by applicable federal, state, or local law or regulation, or otherwise as mutually agreed in writing by the Parties, neither Party shall itself disclose, nor permit any of its Representatives to disclose to any person:

(a) that the Confidential Information has been made available to it or its Representatives, or that it has inspected any portion of the Confidential Information;


- (b) that discussions or negotiations may be, or are, underway between the Parties regarding the Confidential Information or the Purpose, including the status thereof; or
- (c) any terms, terms of this agreement, conditions, or other arrangements that are being discussed or negotiated in relation to the confidential Information or the Purpose.


Entire Understanding: This agreement contains the sum of all parts between the parties, only in writing with both parties may it be amended.
