United Arab Emirates Embassy in Washington D.C.: Yes. During the reporting period, the registrant engaged in political activity as defined under FARA. These activities were undertaken on behalf of the Trade Office of the Embassy of the United Arab Emirates and were limited to trade and investment issues. Examples of such activities included:

- Developing and managing communications materials (digital content and newsletters) describing UAE investment activity in the United States.
- Coordinating and building public-facing assets (website updates, investment tracker, trade map, event promotion) intended to inform U.S. business and policy audiences of the UAE's economic role.
- Supporting outreach through media partnerships and social media channels to highlight UAE-U.S. economic and trade engagement.
- Assisting with planning for Embassy events related to trade/ investment.

These activities were informational in nature, focused exclusively on economic/trade themes, and conducted at the direction of the Trade Office.
