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



***Contract of Services***

This contract of services is signed this February 8th 2025 by and between

1. The **MORRN** (*Movement pour la Reconstruction & la Reconciliation Nationale*) (National Movement to rebuilt and reconcile Haiti.) with its main objective to rebuild Haiti as prosperous and stable country. Represented by Its International Delegate David Lilite ALEXIS.

**And**

2. The **FIRM "The Estopinan Group LLC"**, represented by its President Arthuro ESTOPINAN, duly registered and certified by the Department of Justice of USA., with its main Office located at 2111 Wilson Blvd Alington, VA 22201 , referred as the Firm

*Both the signatories conjointly referred as the Parties*

**Scope of Work**

The Firm will provide representation on behalf of the MORRN on issues pertaining to develop United States support for the return of law and order by getting rid of the gangs with a special experience task forces, modern communication and intelligence support, the return of a free and fairly elected government in the Republic of Haiti.

As part of that effort, The Firm will work to secure United States funding and support through the following phases:

***Phase I: SECURITY AND SAFETY***

- *Special Military Forces with the goal to clean up the gangs areas, to get rid of the violent gangs and neutralize the non-violent ones*
- *Activate the Leahy Law Amendment Waiver with the goal of reinstating the US-HAITI Military Cooperation with sale of adequate military Equipment and proper training to Army and Police training to Army (FAd'H) and Police (PNH)*

***PHASE II: POLITICAL REFORMS AND ELECTIONS***

- *Support of MORRN's governance roadmap with the Chief Justice of the Cassation Court as Provisional President of Haiti and a new Prime Minister*
- *Support of MORRN's political reforms with the goal of the return of the strong Presidential regime and with the goal of transforming the 300 existing political parties into three to five (3) (5) political tendencies so that at the next elections we can have no more than 5 Presidential Candidates*

**PHASE III: *US & International community MARSHALL PLAN FOR HAITI'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT***

- Facilitate access to specialized funds that cover international finance and foreign aid and designated to support global development, humanitarian assistance, such as International Security Assistance (ISA), Foreign Military Financing (FMF), International Disaster Assistance (IDA), Foreign Assistance Funds, Global Environment Facility (GEF), etc.
- Reintroduction of the HOPE & HELP Laws, the reintroduction of *Haiti Criminal Collusion Transparency Act of 2022* with the goal of obtaining more cosponsors and possible movement of the bill, and also the introduction, through the fragility Act
- Support the new Haitian Government accessing to loans and international financial partnerships to boost the national economy, generating jobs and diversifying the national economy...

The Firm will represent MORRN before the United States Government and any other Federal Branches deemed necessary. As part of this commitment, the Firm will actively work to arrange reciprocal visits of MORRN Representatives government Officials. However, it is important to note that the Firm will not be acting as Legal Counsel and will not be providing any legal guidance but will be solely functioning in a political and relationship consulting capacity. Mr. Arthuro ESTIOPNAN GROUP LLC.

**Fees and Expenses**

In consideration for providing the services described hereunder, MORRN agrees to pay a monthly retainer of (Fifteen thousand) \$15,000.00 per month for a one year period commencing February 8th, 2025, payable monthly in advance.

MORN represents that this contract shall only be paid with funds received from sources either duly incorporated or citizens of the United States and further represent and commit that no funds from any foreign source shall be used to pay for services by the Firm. In addition, MORN represents that no foreign entity has any interest or is providing any funding support to this contract.

In addition to the monthly retainer, MORRN agrees to pay all expenses incurred by the Firm on its behalf. The Firm will invoice you for expenses on a monthly basis, and payment is due within thirty (30) days of your receipt of the bill. "Expenses" include but are not limited to business meals, messenger and other third-party vendor charges; charges for transcripts; parking, taxi, and other travel expenses; international telephone; and fees and expenses of professionals retained on your behalf. The Firm will not charge for in-house administrative services such as US long-distance telephone, telecopies and fax transmissions, word processing, and staff overtime.

**Termination of Agreement**

As of July 1, 2025, either MORRN or the Firm may, at their sole discretion, terminate the remainder of this contract with a written 30-day notice. If either MORN or the Firm exercises the termination clause, any fees and expenses incurred previous to or during the 30-day period will remain due and services must still be provided during that term.

**Billing and Fee Recovery**


