**TRANSLATION OF AGREEMENT PROVIDED BY ALMAS SEHIC:**

**MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA**, headquartered in Sarajevo, Musala Street No. 2, represented by the Minister, **Elmedin Konaković** (hereinafter referred to as: the **Client**)

and

**BOSNIAN AMERICAN ALLIANCE INC.**, with its registered office at 2858 University Ave, Madison, Wisconsin 53705, United States of America, represented by \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter referred to as: the **Consultant**),

have on **March 28, 2025**, entered into the following

**AGREEMENT  
ON THE PROVISION OF CONSULTING SERVICES**

**Article 1**

The contracting parties agree that the Consultant, with the aim of protecting and promoting the territorial integrity, sovereignty, and strategic interests of Bosnia and Herzegovina, shall provide the Client with expert advisory services and operational support related to lobbying in the United States of America in accordance with best practices and the applicable laws of the United States.

**Article 2**

The Consultant shall provide the services referred to in Article 1 of this Agreement free of charge.

**Article 3**

The Consultant shall not misuse or disclose to third (unauthorized) parties any data, documents, or information made available to them, either during the performance of duties and tasks or after the completion of work and expiration of this Agreement.

**Article 4**

This Agreement is concluded for a period of one year.

**Article 5**

The Agreement may be terminated by notice, provided that the party wishing to terminate the Agreement must do so in writing.

**Article 6**

The contracting parties conclude this Agreement in good faith.

The contracting parties agree to resolve any potential disputes arising from this Agreement amicably and in the spirit of good business practices. If this is not possible, they agree to the jurisdiction of the **Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina**.

**Article 7**

This Agreement is made in 2 (two) identical copies, with each party retaining 1 (one) copy.
