Williams & Jensen will provide International Merchants LLC strategic consulting and government relations support including engaging with U.S. policymakers in furtherance of the Republic of Indonesia's ("Indonesia") interests with regard to strengthening trade, bilateral defense and security relations as well between the U.S. and Indonesia.

COMPLIANCE TERMS

In executing this Agreement, the parties agree to comply fully with U.S. laws covering the representation of foreign governments and interests in the United States, specifically including the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA).

Williams & Jensen and International Merchants LLC acknowledge and agree that under FARA, Williams & Jensen's activities must be publicly disclosed through regular filings with the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ). FARA also requires public disclosure of contracts with and expenses on behalf of the foreign client that involves covered activities.

Except where Williams & Jensen is found to have knowingly or willfully violated FARA regulations and applicable law, International Merchants LLC will reimburse Williams & Jensen for the portion of legal expenses related to any DOJ audit related to the activities covered under this Agreement.

\*The Parties agree that no work shall begin under this Agreement until a pre-payment of a non-refundable three (3) months of the agreed upon fees is received by Williams & Jensen. The pre-payment shall be due upon the execution of this Agreement and must be received before any services or deliverables are provided. Following the pre-payment, the Parties agree that payments for services will be made on a quarterly basis, with payment due every three (3) months. Williams & Jensen has the right to suspend services if payments are not made in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

We would propose a monthly flat retainer rate of \$50,000 per month for W&J services billed on a quarterly basis.
