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



## SALES REPRESENTATIVE AGREEMENT

This Sales Representative Agreement (this "Agreement") is made and entered into on June 1, 2025 by and between:

- (1) YM CO., LTD, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of Korea, having its principal place of business at 118, Poseunggongdan-ro 118beon-gil, Poseung-eup, Pyeongtaeksi, Gyeonggi-do, Korea ("Company");
- (2) GILLEY'S FASTENER SALES AND CONSULTING LLC for this business opportunity having its principal address at 11800 Merriman Rd. #51781, Livonia, MI 48151, USA ("Agent"); and
- (3) Korea Trade Center Detroit representing Korea Trade Investment Promotion Agency, a non-profit government organization duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of Korea, having its principal place of business at 101 West Big Beaver Rd, Suite 545, Troy, MI 48084 ("KOTRA").

### Article 1 Scope of Services

- 1.1 Company intends to appoint Agent, and Agent accepts to be appointed by Company, to actively promote the sales of Company's products in North America and perform other services related thereto (the "Services").
- 1.2 KOTRA is willing to support Company under the World Champ Program. KOTRA shall bear no legal liability under this Agreement except for the payment to Agent for the Services and shall be indemnified against all claims, damages, losses and expenses arising in relation to the Agent's Services under this Agreement.
- 1.3 The parties agree that this Agreement is a service contract and not an employment contract and does not create any employment relationship between the parties. For the avoidance of doubt, the payment made by KOTRA and Company under Article 4 below shall be deemed only as retainer fees for the services provided by Agent and not as salary or payroll. KOTRA shall not bear any obligation or liability in relation to employment insurance benefits for Agent.

**Article 2 Duration**

Subject to the provisions for the termination under Article 5 below, this Agreement shall become effective from June 1, 2025 and shall remain in effect until Dec 31, 2025. This Agreement shall end upon expiration of the said term, unless all parties agree otherwise in writing.

**Article 3 Rights and Obligations**

- 3.1 Agent shall use its best efforts to promote the sale of Company's products and provide the Services.
- 3.2 Agent shall fully cooperate to provide various materials or relevant documents, reference books, etc. related to the execution of the Services.
- 3.3 Agent shall submit monthly report in writing to Company and KOTRA.
- 3.4 Company shall use its efforts to assist and cooperate with Agent for successful performance of the Services and KOTRA shall make payment for the Services in the amount defined in Article 4 below.

**Article 4 Payment**

- 4.1 The fixed payment for each month shall be paid to Agent in the amount of USD \$16,100 on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month. Remuneration for periods of less than one month shall be calculated on a daily basis.
- 4.2 The payment by KOTRA and Company to Agent for each month shall be subject to Agent's submission of monthly report including monthly invoice to KOTRA by the end of each month.
- 4.3 Notwithstanding the provisions above, with respect to the month of December, Agent shall submit the monthly report and invoice by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month, and KOTRA shall make payment to Agent in the amount of USD \$16,100 by December 22, 2025.

- 4.4 The monthly payment shall include all local expenses for the performance of the Services; provided airfare and lodging expenses for business travels of Agent may be reimbursed by Company if the parties have agreed in writing for the payment of such reimbursement.

**Article 5 Termination**

- 5.1 This Agreement shall terminate upon the last day of the duration set forth in Article 2 above.
- 5.2 This Agreement may be terminated by KOTRA, Company or Agent with a prior written notice of 30 days, without further cause, in any of the following cases:
- (1) By mutual agreement in writing of the parties;
  - (2) By the non-defaulting party, in the event of default by the other party in the due performance of its obligations under this Agreement, and the default is not remedied within 30 days after receipt of written notice of default from the non-defaulting party;
  - (3) By the other party, either party making an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or being adjudged bankrupt or insolvent, or filing any petition seeking for itself any arrangement for dissolution and liquidation of its interests;
  - (4) By either party, if a force majeure condition under Article 7 below makes it unreasonable to proceed with this Agreement in the foreseeable future;
  - (5) By Company if Agent commits any intentional acts that materially impair or damage the goodwill, business or property of Company;

**Article 6 Indemnification**

Each party shall indemnify the other parties against all claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of one's duty hereunder that are caused in whole or in part by the indemnifying party's intentional or negligent acts or omissions, acts in excess of authority granted hereunder, or acts of those employed or associated by the indemnifying party.

**Article 7 Force Majeure**

The parties shall be suspended from liability for force majeure circumstances (i.e. natural disasters, industrial disturbances, strikes and lockouts, wars, riots, fires, storms, explosions, legislative amendments, etc.) during the continuance of the cause, provided the cause is remedied with reasonable dispatch. The party which is affected by force majeure circumstances shall inform the other parties of such circumstances no later than 15 days.

**Article 8 Confidential Information**

- 8.1 By virtue of this Agreement, a party ("**Disclosing Party**") may disclose its confidential information ("**Confidential Information**") to the other parties ("**Receiving Party**"). The Receiving Party agrees that it will not use or disclose such Confidential Information and proprietary information during the term of this Agreement or at any time thereafter, without the express written consent of the Disclosing Party, except only as necessary to effectuate the terms of this Agreement.
- 8.2 The Receiving Party agrees that the provision of this Article shall survive the termination (for any reason) or breach of this Agreement. In the event of the Receiving Party's violation of its duty under this Article, the Disclosing Party may, in addition to pursuing its other remedies, obtain equitable injunctive relief from any court of competent jurisdiction as may be necessary or reasonable to enjoin any such violation of the foregoing restraints.

**Article 9 Governing Law and Arbitration**


9.1 This Agreement shall be governed and interpreted by the laws of Republic of Korea.

9.2 In case of any dispute arising out of, or in connection with this Agreement, the parties shall take all necessary actions to settle amicably by negotiations between the parties. If a dispute is not settled amicably, it shall be finally settled by arbitration in Seoul, in accordance with and governed by the laws of Republic of Korea. English language shall be used in the arbitral proceedings.
