The USRCA is comprised of 8 elected officers with a 3 year term renewable once. The Executive Team is made up of the President, Vice President, Secretary General, Treasurer, 4 commissioners, namely: Youth & Culture, Gender Balance, Skills & Knowledge Transfer and Mobilization.

The Executive Team is assigned a number of local communities and are responsible to check on the communities for any needs that may affect them locally or nationally. The Executive Team serves as a source of information gathered on their behalf, from the government of Rwanda, or any other entity that has interest in the community at large for the local communities as well.

The designated Team member will also be tasked to follow up on any activities in the assigned territory are reportable and thus provide it in time for any reporting necessary.
