

Appendix Response to Item 8

Item 8: Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

In 2022, the U.S. Congress passed the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), which had a significant impact on Korean companies like Hyundai Motors and the Korean economy. At the time, the National Assembly was not properly aware of the bill's initiation and passage and only became aware of its contents after it became a media issue.

Additionally, there was an issue regarding who should handle protocol—the National Assembly or the Ministry of Foreign Affairs—when former Speaker of the House Nancy Pelosi visited Korea.

This led to the realization that, in addition to traditional diplomacy at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and government levels, there was a need to secure more direct communication channels between the U.S. Congress and the Korean National Assembly and to more closely monitor key legislative activities in the U.S. Congress that affect Korea.

Then-Speaker of the National Assembly Kim Jin-pyo ordered the establishment of a separate corporation to promote exchanges between the U.S. Congress and the Korean National Assembly, and specific plans to establish a congressional exchange center in the U.S. began to be explored.
