



Item 8: Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.

MN Target is providing informal assistance to members of the Druze religious and spiritual community which includes one or more members of the Israeli Knesset as they prepare for a short, humanitarian mission to the United States from September 6-14, 2025. The purpose of the mission is to raise awareness of the persecution of Druze and other religious minorities in Syria. As part of this mission, the delegation seeks to meet with members of the United States Congress who have expressed interest in preserving religious freedom and human rights.

As of the date of this letter, the consultancy (foreign principal) assisting the delegation has not been formally retained by the MKs, the spiritual leaders of the delegation or any other foreign principal.

The scope of the Applicant with the foreign principal is

- Assisting with scheduling and coordinating meetings with Members of Congress with the consultancy being the primary contact for this delegation.
- Assisting with logistics, including arranging transportation and driving the delegation.
- Attending meetings only in a clerical capacity (e.g., confirming logistics, handling coordination, taking photos or note-taking if requested).
- Providing clerical assistance to the Israeli consultancy firm with follow-up correspondence such as formatting or transmitting letters prepared by the delegation, but not drafting substantive content or policy messaging.
- Applicant will not speak on behalf of the consultancy, the MKs, the spiritual leaders, or any foreign entity, nor will Applicant engage in advocacy or policy discussions.
- Applicant will not receive any salary, fees, or honoraria. Compensation may include lodging accommodations, meals, reimbursement of the FARA registration fee, and incidental travel support related to the delegation's visit

This Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into on this 29th day of August, 2025, by and between:

Nitzan Meir, ("Nitzan") who owns a consultancy, MN Target Consultants ("MN Target" or the "Consultancy").

and

Jonathan Goldstein, an individual ("Jonathan").

WHEREAS, Nitzan and the Consultancy is assisting Druze leaders in Israel, including spiritual and religious leaders, local mayors and a member of Knesset in a humanitarian mission to the United States (the "Druze Delegation") to shed light on the genocide in Syria to the Druze and other persecuted religious minorities;

WHEREAS, Nitzan and the Consultancy is providing informal assistance to Druze leaders in Israel, to the Druze Delegation, a short, humanitarian mission to the United States from September 6-14, 2025 the ("Mission"); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Mission is to raise awareness of the persecution of Druze and other religious minorities in Syria. As part of this mission, the Druze Delegation seeks to meet with members of the United States Congress who have expressed interest in preserving religious freedom and human rights; and


WHEREAS, the Consultancy has requested Jonathan to assist the Consultancy with the Druze Delegation as Nitzan's assistant in charge of coordination and logistics.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assistance with Druze Delegation

Jonathan agrees to:

- Assist with scheduling and coordinating meetings with Members of Congress with the Consultancy being the primary contact for this Druze Delegation.
- Assist with logistics, including arranging transportation and driving the Druze Delegation to all of its meetings and events.
- Attend meetings only in a clerical capacity (e.g., confirming logistics, handling coordination, taking photos or note-taking if requested).
- Direct all press inquiries to Nitzan.
- Provide clerical assistance to Nitzan with follow-up correspondence such as formatting or transmitting letters prepared by the Delegation, but not drafting substantive content or policy messaging.



Jonathan will not speak on behalf of the consultancy, the Druze Delegation, the individual spiritual leaders, or any foreign entity, nor will he engage in advocacy or policy discussions. All inquiries will be directed to the Consultancy who will be communicating to the Druze Delegation.

2. Compensation

Jonathan will not receive any salary, fees, or honoraria from the Druze Delegation or the Consultancy.

Compensation may include lodging accommodations, meals, reimbursement of the FARA registration fee, and incidental travel support related to the delegation's visit

The Consultancy is not being compensated for its support of the Humanitarian Mission and will receive flights, travel support, accommodations and meals from the Druze Delegation.

3. Term

The Term of this engagement is limited to the logistics and planning prior to the visit on September 6th through September 14th when the Druze Delegation leaves the United States and any additional administrative follow-up matters regarding the Druze Delegation.

4. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to keep confidential all non-public information, trade secrets, client data, and any proprietary materials exchanged or learned in the course of their collaboration, unless disclosure is required by law. This obligation shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

5. Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA) Exemption

The parties understand that humanitarian and religious activities contemplated under this Agreement is conducted in what is believed to be furtherance of exempt activities under the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, 22 U.S.C. § 611 et seq. ("FARA" or "the Act"), including but not limited to: humanitarian fundraising, and pursuits that are religious, scholastic, academic, fine arts, or scientific in nature.

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to require registration under the Act. In the event that registration under FARA may be triggered by a specific engagement.

Out of an abundance of caution, Jonathan will file a pre-cautionary registration with FARA following the execution of this agreement and request an interpretation as to whether these primarily administrative and logistics service on behalf of the consultancy for the Druze Delegation rises to FARA Registration.

6. Miscellaneous
