<p><u>The Crisis</u></p> <p>In December 2024, Ahmed Hussein Al-Sharaa (<i>Abu Mohammed al-Julani</i>), leader of Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS), seized control of Syria. <i>Since then, his forces have carried out a campaign of genocide and ethnic cleansing against minorities.</i></p> <p><u>Targets of Persecution</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alawites: initial massacres despite surrender agreements. • Druze: siege warfare, abductions, targeted killings. • Christians, Yazidis, Kurds: displacement, destruction of villages, killings. <p><u>Why the Druze Matter</u></p> <p>The Druze are an ancient Abrahamic-rooted community. In Israel, Druze citizens serve with distinction in the IDF, Knesset, judiciary, and local government.</p> <p><u>Key Concerns</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Active Genocide in Progress – killings and displacement. 2. Hostage Crisis – dozens abducted. 3. Humanitarian Blockade – aid cut off. 4. Regional Destabilization – terrorists in governance. 5. Moral Failure Risk – <i>inaction undermines U.S. leadership</i> 	<p><u>America's Record</u></p> <p>The United States has a longstanding moral record of recognizing genocides against Christians, Yazidis, and Kurds in Iraq and Syria—standing up to defend the persecuted when called upon. <i>Today, the Druze and other minorities face annihilation.</i></p> <p><u>Necessary Policy Actions</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Recognize the Syrian minorities Genocide. 2. Demilitarize Suwayda Province. 3. Establish a Humanitarian Corridor. 4. Secure Release of Captives. 5. Launch a Commission of Inquiry. 6. Include Druze Leadership. 7. Provide U.S. Security Guarantees. <p><u>The Call to Action</u></p> <p>“Seek justice. Defend the oppressed.” (Isaiah 1:17) “Whatever you did for one of the least of these... you did for me.” (Matthew 25:40)</p> <p><i>The United States has both the moral responsibility and strategic interest to act now.</i></p>
