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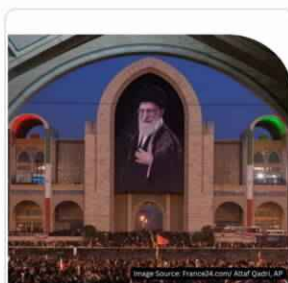

Hezbollah's History Matters

Another conflict would be devastating.

It would further damage infrastructure, discourage international investment, delay economic recovery and deepen humanitarian challenges affecting communities across the country.

The interests of ordinary Lebanese citizens are therefore closely aligned with maintaining stability rather than returning to confrontation.

That objective becomes considerably more difficult while a heavily armed non-state actor continues preparing^[3] for future conflict.

International Efforts Point in the Same Direction

Recent diplomatic initiatives have increasingly recognised that Lebanon's long-term stability requires strengthening state institutions while reducing the influence of armed organisations operating independently of the government.

The recently signed Trilateral Framework^[5], signed by the U.S., Lebanon and Israel, similarly emphasised that full Lebanese sovereignty cannot be achieved while non-state armed organisations remain armed.

This reflects a growing international consensus.

A stable Lebanon requires one legitimate authority responsible for national defence.

As long as Hezbollah maintains an independent military structure, that objective remains difficult to achieve.

Breaking the Cycle

The repeated pattern of conflict, reconstruction and rearmament has imposed enormous costs on both Lebanon and Israel.

Each round of fighting leaves civilian communities on both sides of the border bearing the consequences, while opportunities for long-term economic development and regional cooperation are postponed once again.

Breaking that cycle requires more than temporary ceasefires.

It requires durable security arrangements that prevent military rearmament during periods of calm and create conditions in which diplomacy can succeed.

Without those foundations, every ceasefire risks becoming merely an intermission before the next confrontation.

Conclusion

Reports that Hezbollah may already be preparing for another war should serve as a reminder that the absence of active fighting does not necessarily indicate the presence of lasting peace.

If the organisation continues rebuilding its military capabilities while awaiting strategic direction from Tehran, it risks undermining both the ceasefire and broader international efforts to stabilise Lebanon. Such preparations would not only threaten Israel's security but also delay Lebanon's recovery at a time when the country urgently needs economic reconstruction, effective governance and renewed international confidence.



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The people of Lebanon deserve a future shaped by investment, reform and stability rather than repeated cycles of conflict.

Achieving that future depends in large part on ensuring that ceasefires are used to build peace—not to prepare for the next war.
