

We trust that your moral influence, wisdom, and compassion will strengthen this noble cause and open new avenues of understanding and support in the international community.

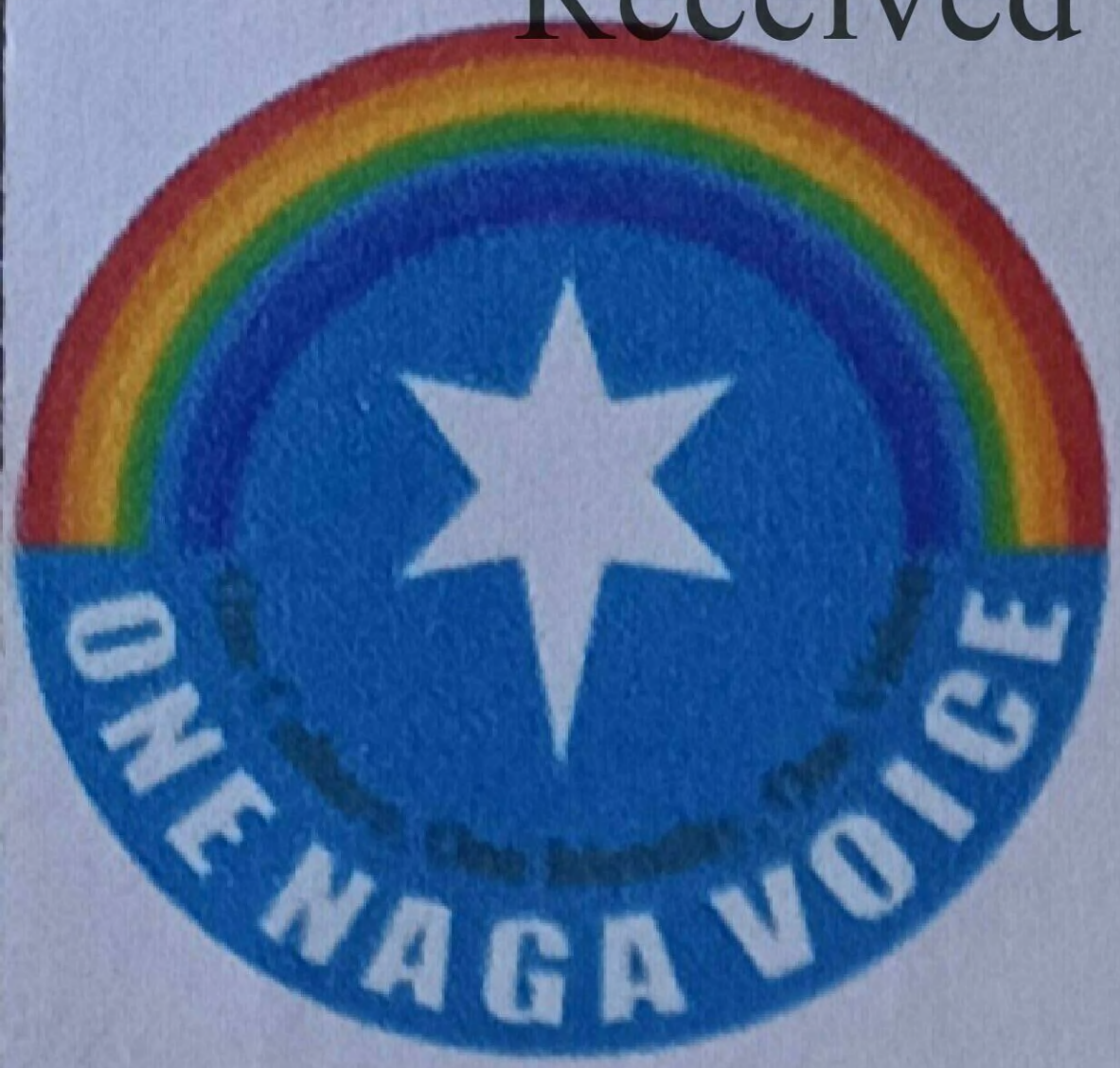
Please accept this appointment as a token of our deep respect and gratitude, and as a mark of confidence in your leadership and friendship towards the Naga people.
