

Services and Political Activity Description: Registrant will provide services and representation, together with one or more strategic advisors engaged by Eversheds Sutherland on behalf of the foreign principal, including providing strategic counsel, tactical planning, and assisting with government relations on matters before the U.S. Government, the U.S. Congress, state governments, academic institutions, think tanks, and other relevant stakeholders as may be requested by the foreign principal from time to time in order to broadly establish, strengthen and consolidate the national security of Romania by broadly strengthening the strategic partnership / cooperation between the United States and Romania and generally bolstering the relations between the two countries.
