Graduated from Ecole Normale Superieur (E.N.S.), Bambili, Cameroon. Taught Biology in Government Bilingual High School Bamenda before moving to the United States in 1984.

Enrolled at Howard University, Washington D.C. Undergraduate School with the intention to pursue studies in biology up-to post graduate level to continue teaching, a profession I love because of my passion for people's wellbeing. My realities at the time made it impossible for me to pursue studies in biology so I switched to Pharmacy. Graduated in 1989 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy.

I worked as a retail pharmacist in chain drug stores: Rite Aid Pharmacy and Giant Pharmacy for 30 years, from 1989 to 2019 when I retired. Pharmacy gave me the same opportunity to interact and care for people's wellbeing as teaching. Customer service was my greatest strength. Whilst working as a full-time pharmacist, I also got a real estate license and did real estate part time for about 4 years.

As a retiree, I am a Life Insurance Agent with World Financial Group (WFG). Two years ago, I founded, Blessed Assurance Financial Services, LLC. I do insurance business part time, most of my time I spend volunteering. I volunteer in church, ACCENT CARE – a palliative care agency, and Friends of Ambazonia Inc., an advocacy organization, advocating on behalf of the suffering people of the former British Southern Cameroons also known as Ambazonia for an end to the war and the recognition of their Self- Determination. ### **Biography Of Rev. Dr. Victor M. Njei**

Rev. Dr. Victor M, Njei is the Founder and Senior Pastor of Omega Gospel Ministries in Houston, Texas, a 501(c)(3) organization with over 25 years of continuous service to families and communities. He is a US Citizen and hails from the Northwest Region of Southern Cameroon and brings a rare blend of engineering discipline, theological depth, and global leadership experience to his work.

He earned a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from (Polytechnic) now known as University of Technology in Calabar, Nigeria, after which he returned to Cameroon to serve in the Department of Public Works in Bamenda. During this period, he was appointed Provincial Coordinator for Cameroon Youths for Jesus, a non-denominational Christian outreach group best organization of youth evangelism and community empowerment.

Responding to the call of God, Rev. Dr. Njei pursued theological training at Rhema Bible College in Johannesburg, South Africa, where he graduated and ordained Reverend in 1989. He subsequently traveled to Germany where he served as a missionary in cities of Essen and Bielefeld, respectively.

His ministry journey later brought him to the United States, where he initially served alongside Rev. Dr. Toby Awasum and First Dr Jeannette Awasum of Omega Gospel Mission in Washington, D.C. In 2001, he relocated to Houston, Texas, where he founded Omega Gospel Ministries, which he continues to lead as Senior Pastor.

Rev. Dr. Mbah's ministry spans three continents—Africa, Europe, and North America, reflecting a lifelong commitment to spiritual leadership, cross-cultural evangelism, and community transformation. In Houston, he has been a consistent advocate for love, peace, reconciliation, and family stability, positively impacting countless individuals and households.

Demonstrating a strong commitment to lifelong community and leadership excellence, Rev. Dr. Njei is an author of two books one on, Marriage and the other on Church leadership in the Cooperate world.
