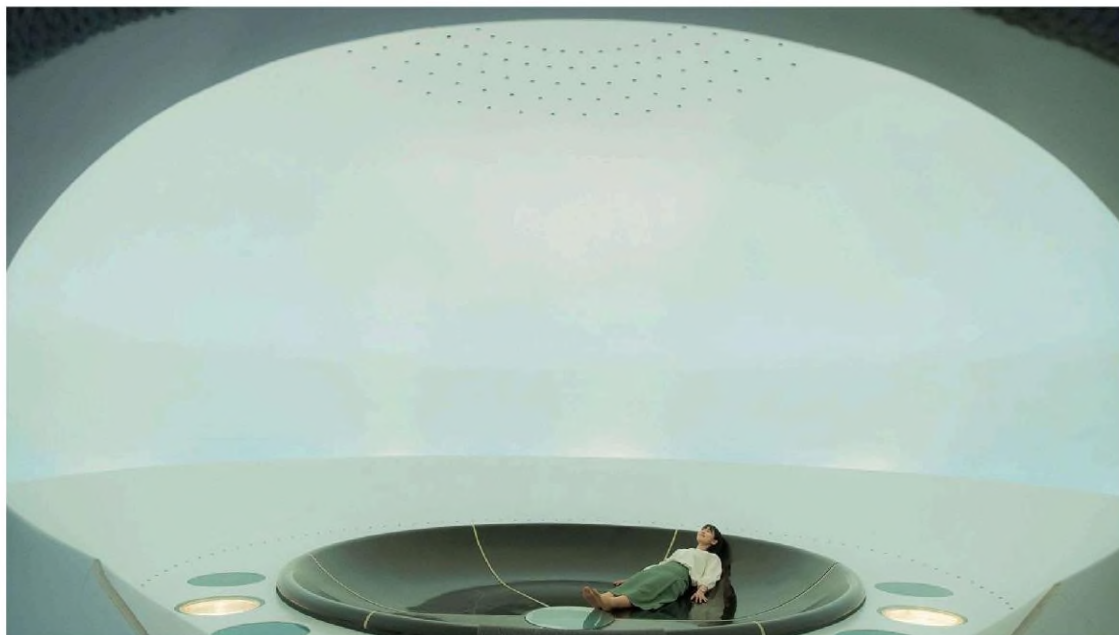

Rare Scroll Painting on Display in Kyoto

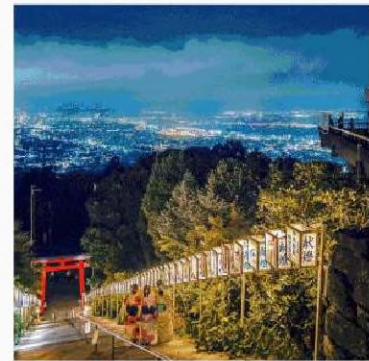
