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CONSULTATION SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Consultation Services Agreement is made and entered into on this 18th day of February 2026 between WE EMPLOYMENT AMERICA INC hereinafter referred to as "Client" or "the Client" and National Strategic Advisors PLLC, hereinafter referred to as "Firm" or "the Firm", both of whom comprise the parties to this contract.

WHEREAS the Client wishes to obtain the consultation services of the Firm; and the Firm has the knowledge, skill and capability to perform such services for the Client.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the following, the parties intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

The Firm will represent the Client's best interests before the United States Government to include the United States Senate and Congress and its committees, the federal executive branch and its agencies, and other governmental entities, agencies or departments of the federal government.

RESULTS NOT GUARANTEED - The Firm does not warranty or guarantee any results related to the services rendered. The Client expressly acknowledges that the Firm has not given, and cannot give, any predictions or guarantee of the outcome of any government affairs matters, or other matter for which the Firm is retained, nor is this contract contingent on such outcome.

The Client agrees to cooperate fully with the Firm and to provide all information known by, or available to, the Client which may aid the Firm in representing the Client;

WHEREAS the parties have agreed to the terms under which the Firm will represent the Client and wish to memorialize their agreement in writing.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals and the mutual covenants herein contained and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

1. Term of Agreement: This agreement shall become effective on February 18, 2026, and shall remain effective until February 18, 2027, and will automatically renew annually, unless either party gives written notice of non-renewal. The agreement may be terminated by either party for any reason by providing 30-days written notice to the other party.



2. Duties & Obligations of the Firm: It shall be the Firm's duty to advocate for the interests of the Client before the federal government to include the United States Senate and Congress and its committees, the federal executive branch and its agencies, and other governmental entities, agencies or departments of the federal government.

3. Duties of Client: It shall be the Client's duty to timely compensate the Firm for its services and to keep the Firm informed of any substantive changes which may materially affect this agreement or its scope of services.

4. Compensation: The Firm shall receive from Client \$300,000.00 USD annually, payable on the 15th day of every month at the monthly rate of \$25,000.00 USD.

5. Costs and Expenses – The Client shall be responsible for reimbursement of costs and expenses such as airfare, lodging, transportation, telephone and meals while traveling at a per diem rate of \$300.00 USD. Costs also include copying, postage, and delivery, document translations, authentications, certifications, apostilles, etc. Additionally, Client is responsible for any and all costs incurred in the event that the Firm is required to contract a secondary or intermediary entity or other professional on Client's behalf. Any such arrangement must be agreed to in writing by the parties prior to the engagement of such services or professionals. Any individual expense over \$300.00 USD, must be approved by the Client prior to the expense being incurred.

5. Registration, Disclosure and Compliance: The Firm shall comply with all applicable federal laws, ordinances and rules regarding registration, disclosure, compensation/expense reporting and compliance, including but not limited to compliance under the Foreign Agents Registration Act. National Strategic Advisors is only responsible for any local, state, or federal registration requirements, including but not limited to registration required under the Foreign Agents Registration Act ("FARA"), for employees of National Strategic Advisors. As such, the Firm will not be responsible, or held liable, for the local, state, or federal registration requirements for any advocacy the Client engages in either independent of the Firm or in collaboration with the Firm.


6. Venue and Governing Law: Venue for all proceedings in connection with this contract shall be in the State Courts in Miami-Dade County, Florida, and all aspects of this contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida.
