Privacy Act Statement. The filing of this document is required for the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended, 22 U.S.C. § 611 *et seq.*, for the purposes of registration under the Act and public disclosure. Provision of the information requested is mandatory, and failure to provide the information is subject to the penalty and enforcement provisions established in Section 8 of the Act. Every registration statement, short form registration statement, supplemental statement, exhibit, amendment, copy of informational materials or other document or information filed with the Attorney General under this Act is a public record open to public examination, inspection and copying during the posted business hours of the FARA Unit in Washington, DC. Statements are also available online at the FARA Unit's webpage: <https://www.fara.gov>. One copy of every such document, other than informational materials, is automatically provided to the Secretary of State pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Act, and copies of any and all documents are routinely made available to other agencies, departments and Congress pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Act. The Attorney General also transmits a semi-annual report to Congress on the administration of the Act which lists the names of all agents registered under the Act and the foreign principals they represent. Item 11: Describe in detail all services which you will render to the foreign principal listed in Item 10 either directly, or through the primary registrant listed in Item 8.

Services include representing Yap State with regard to the Department of War proposed projects to expand the airport and seaport in Yap State, including representation of Yap State in the NEPA process, attending scoping meetings, requesting and commenting on natural and cultural resource surveys, working with Yap State leadership to draft and submit comments during scoping commenting period, working with Yap State leadership to comment on administrative draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), draft EIS, and final EIS. Services also include representing Yap State in negotiating standard operating procedures for the application of NEPA, for application of U.S. environmental laws pursuant to provisions in the FSM-US Compact of Free Association, for endangered species consultation, for biosecurity requirements, and for cultural resource consultations under the US Historic Preservation Act. Services further include negotiating operational control letters and defense site designations. Services include application of FAA requirements to Yap State Airport.
