Re: Legal Services Engagement

Dear Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of the Interior,

This letter agreement confirms that you, Sar Sokha (the “Client” or “your”), in your personal capacity, have retained Seiden Law LLP (“Seiden Law,” “we,” or “us”) to provide legal services and assistance in connection with communications with the U.S. Treasury’s Office of Foreign Assets Control (“OFAC”) and a certain U.S. Congressional Committee for the purpose of addressing any potential wrongful inclusion of you in H.R. 5490 or otherwise designated by OFAC or the U.S. State Department for related allegations (the “Matter”).

Scope of Representation

Federal Agency Communication

In addition, we will communicate with the OFAC as needed regarding this Matter.

Separately, as necessary, we will manage and conduct communications with relevant U.S. government officials, including the U.S. Congress on your behalf concerning the basis for which your name was included in H.R. 5490.
