### Advisory Agreement

**Party One / Office of the Prime Minister / represented by Mr. (Ihsan Yassin Al-Awadi), Director of the Office of the Prime Minister / in addition to his regular duties.**

**Party B: Mr. Bakr Asaad Ali.**

**Based on the requirements of the public interest, Cabinet Decision No. (262) of 2026, and the approval of the Prime Minister, it is hereby decided to enter into a contract between the aforementioned parties in accordance with the following provisions:**

#### **I. Obligations of the First Party:**

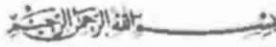
1. The First Party undertakes to provide the necessary resources and conditions for the Second Party's work.
2. The Second Party shall be granted annual leave not exceeding (30) days per year.

#### **Second: Obligations of the Second Party:**

1. The Second Party undertakes to provide services to the Prime Minister in the capacity of "advisor" and to perform any tasks assigned to it by the First Party.
2. Party B undertakes to complete the work entrusted to it and to devote time during working hours to Party A's business.
3. The Second Party undertakes to maintain the confidentiality of any information it receives in the course of its work, unless authorized to disclose such information by the First Party.
4. The Second Party undertakes to provide the services required of it within the framework of this contract, including working five (5) days a week, provided that the First Party shall determine the official dates and times for the Second Party's presence at the First Party's headquarters.
- 5- The Second Party undertakes to notify the Office of the Prime Minister / Administrative Department in the event that it receives any salary from any government entity; otherwise, it shall bear the legal consequences.
6. The Second Party undertakes to open an account with Al-Rafidain Bank for the purpose of receiving the financial entitlements granted to it via electronic payment.

#### **Third: Term and Value of the Contract:**

1. The contract term (one year) shall begin on the start date and may be extended with the consent of both parties.
- 2- The Second Party is obligated to provide its services to the First Party for a monthly fee of (2,000,000) two million Iraqi dinars only.

IV. Termination of the Contract:

1. The First Party may terminate the contract at any time by providing the Second Party with written notice at least (10) days prior to the date of termination.
2. The Second Party shall have the right to request termination of the contract at any time, provided that the First Party is notified in writing at least (30) days prior to the Second Party's cessation of work.

V. General Provisions:

1. Any intellectual property rights arising during the term of this contract (including reports, inventions, business methods, electronic systems and programs, or other works owned by the First Party)
  2. The General Contract Implementation Instructions No. (1) of 2025 shall apply unless otherwise specified in this contract.
  - 3- The courts of Baghdad shall have exclusive jurisdiction to hear any dispute arising between the parties regarding the interpretation or application of the provisions of this contract.
  4. This contract is subject to the laws of Iraq currently in force.
5. This contract is subject to the amended Income Tax Law No. 113 of 1982.
6. Arabic is the official language adopted for this contract.
