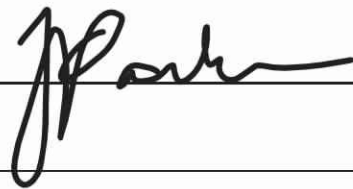

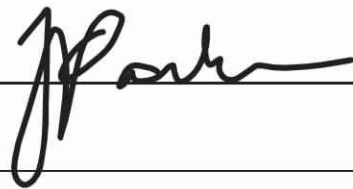

CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT

Between

The Office of the Ruler of Ras Al Khaimah, represented by Lody Embrechts, having its principal office in Ras Al Khaimah, United Arab Emirates ("Client");

and

JP Resolutions Consulting (DBA JP Global Advisors) ("Consultant")

Effective Date: 3rd August 2026

Term: Twelve (12) Months (renewable for one additional twelve (12) month term by mutual written agreement).

1. Purpose

The Client appoints the Consultant to support the implementation of the Miami–Ras Al Khaimah Strategic Partnership by developing and facilitating governmental, institutional, academic and commercial cooperation in South Florida.

The Consultant shall work under the direction of the International Relations Department of the Office of the Ruler.

2. Term

This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and shall remain in force for an initial period of twelve (12) months, unless terminated earlier in accordance with this Agreement.

At the end of the initial twelve (12) month term, this Agreement may be renewed for another twelve (12) months by mutual written agreement of the Parties.

Performance shall be reviewed every six (6) months. Continuation beyond the initial twelve-month term, and any subsequent payments, are subject to satisfactory performance and the Client's written approval.

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3. Retainer and Payment

The Consultant shall receive a retainer of **USD 25,000 per month during the initial term**, for a maximum contract value of **USD 300,000**.

Payments shall be made every six (6) months (USD 150,000), payable within fifteen business days of the Effective Date and receipt of the Consultant's invoice subject to:

- submission of a six-month progress report;
- achievement of agreed KPIs;
- submission of the implementation plan and budget for the following six months; and
- written approval by the Client.

Payments shall become due only after the Client confirms that the payment conditions have been satisfied. Both Parties shall work in good faith to ensure the timely submission, review, approval and payment of all required documentation and invoices, so as to avoid unnecessary delays to the implementation and momentum of the agreed projects and initiatives.

4. Scope of Services

The Consultant shall provide strategic advisory and implementation support, including:

- implementation of the Miami-Ras Al Khaimah City Partnership;
- development of governmental, institutional and commercial relationships;
- identification of investment and partnership opportunities;
- coordination of meetings and stakeholder engagement;
- facilitation of negotiations and partnerships;
- strategic advice to the International Relations Department;
- ongoing market intelligence and opportunity identification.

Quarterly market intelligence updates shall be provided.

5. September 2026 Scoping Mission

The Consultant shall organize and facilitate the official visit of the International Relations Department and participating Ras Al Khaimah entities to Miami.

The mission is included within the monthly retainer and shall not attract additional professional fees.

Travel, accommodation, venue hire and other approved operational expenses shall be reimbursed separately, subject to prior written approval.

6. Six-Month Planning

Within thirty (30) days of commencement, and every six months thereafter, the Consultant shall submit for approval:

- an implementation plan;
- work programme;
- a proposed KPI framework;
- stakeholder engagement plan; and
- estimated budget for activities and reimbursable expenses for the following six months.

No activities requiring additional funding shall commence without prior written approval.

7. Reporting

The Consultant shall provide:

Monthly

- progress update;
- pipeline of opportunities;
- activities undertaken;
- meetings held;
- next month's priorities.

Every six (6) Months

A comprehensive report covering results achieved, KPI performance, partnerships developed, investment opportunities, implementation progress and recommendations for the next six-month period. Deliverables will be considered accepted within ten (10) business days of submission unless the Client provides written feedback requesting reasonable clarifications or adjustments.

8. Key Performance Indicators

Within thirty (30) days of signing, the Parties shall agree measurable KPIs covering, among others:

- government engagement;
- partnership development;

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- investment opportunities;
- implementation of the City Agreement;
- stakeholder satisfaction;
- quality and timeliness of deliverables.

KPIs may be amended by mutual written agreement.

9. Performance Review and Termination

The Client shall conduct a formal performance review every six months.

The Client may terminate this Agreement with ten (10) days notice if the Consultant fails to achieve agreed KPIs, materially underperforms, breaches confidentiality, creates reputational risk, or otherwise materially breaches this Agreement. Before termination, the Client shall provide written notice identifying the deficiency and allow the Consultant thirty days to cure or submit a mutually acceptable remediation plan.

The Client may also terminate the Agreement for convenience upon thirty (30) days' written notice.

The Consultant may terminate this Agreement upon reasonable written notice to the Client. The Parties shall work together in good faith to agree on an appropriate transition period, taking into account the status of active deliverables, stakeholder engagements, and ongoing initiatives. During such period, the Consultant shall use commercially reasonable efforts to complete agreed deliverables then in progress and facilitate an orderly transition.

Payment shall only be made for services satisfactorily performed up to the termination date.

10. Expenses and Additional Activities

The monthly retainer covers all professional services described in this Agreement.

Travel, accommodation, venue hire, hospitality, marketing, event costs and other reimbursable expenses require prior written approval.

The Client reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to engage third-party consultants, event organisers or service providers for activities outside the scope of the monthly retainer whenever this is considered operationally advantageous or offers better value for money. The Consultant shall cooperate fully with such third parties where requested by the Client.

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11. Confidentiality

The Consultant shall keep all information relating to the Client confidential and shall not make any public statements regarding this Agreement nor represent the Client's official position without prior written approval from the Client.

Nothing in this Agreement shall prevent the Consultant from referring to publicly available information regarding the opportunities for investments and strategic partnerships in Ras Al Khaimah or publicly announced initiatives, milestones, events or collaborations, provided that such communications are accurate, do not disclose Confidential Information, do not purport to represent the Client's official position, and are consistent with the objectives of this Agreement.

The Consultant may use a mutually approved description of the engagement in professional biographies, credentials, business-development materials and social media without requiring separate approval for each use.

The Consultant may publish articles, interviews and thought leadership relating to Ras Al Khaimah, provided such content is based solely on publicly available information or information approved for publication by the Client and does not disclose Confidential Information or represent the Client's official position unless expressly authorized.

The Consultant shall use commercially reasonable efforts to coordinate with the Client and the relevant RAK entities (including the RAK Media Office, where appropriate) to obtain any approvals required under this Agreement. Any such approval shall remain subject to the Client's sole discretion.

Furthermore, the Consultant shall not use the Client's name, trademarks, or trade names in any manner or for any promotional purpose whatsoever without such prior written consent.

12. Intellectual Property

The Client shall own final project-specific deliverables created exclusively for and paid for by the Client. The Consultant shall retain ownership of all pre-existing materials, methodologies, templates, know-how, databases, relationship networks, contact information independently developed or obtained, and general intellectual capital.

The Consultant shall promptly disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest relating to the services under this Agreement.
