Agreement and Statement of Work for the United States

Geopolitical Solutions LLC d/b/a GeoPols ("Agency") will support the Embassy of the Republic of Yemen, Washington, D.C. ("Client") with strategic communications and related services in Washington, D.C. and the United States, including:

- Strategic communications counsel
- Traditional, digital, and social media monitoring and analysis
- Media and stakeholder relations
- Coordination with approved third-party vendors, consultants, and partners

Fees

Client will pay Agency a base retainer of USD \$110,000 per month for the above work directed in Washington, DC, and the United States of America.

The first two monthly retainers shall be invoiced upon execution of this Agreement and shall be due within sixty (60) days of the invoice date. Thereafter, the monthly retainer shall be invoiced monthly and shall be due within sixty (60) days of the invoice date.

The agency may suspend services if any invoice remains unpaid for more than ninety (90) days after its due date. Any suspension for nonpayment shall not constitute a termination of this Agreement or relieve Client of its payment obligations under this Agreement.

Should the Client request services that fall materially outside the above scope or require significant additional resources, the Agency will discuss such requirements with the Client in advance. No additional fees or material third-party expenses will be incurred without Client's prior written approval and, once approved, will be invoiced separately. Such expenses may include, but are not limited to, travel, event production, or other mutually agreed pass-through costs.

Agreement Terms

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon sixty (60) days' prior written notice. Termination shall not relieve Client of its obligation to pay fees and approved expenses through the effective date of termination. Agency may suspend or terminate this Agreement for material nonpayment in accordance with the payment provisions above or immediately upon written notice for any other material breach.

Client is responsible for the accuracy and completeness of information, materials, permissions, and instructions supplied to Agency and for timely review and approval of materials requiring Client approval. Client shall promptly provide the requested approvals, feedback, information, and decisions, taking into account applicable deadlines and the time-sensitive nature of the services. Delays in Client approvals, information, or decisions may result in corresponding

adjustments to applicable timelines and deliverables. They shall not affect applicable payment timelines or the Client's obligation to pay amounts due under this Agreement.

Client shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Agency, its affiliated entities, and their respective officers, directors, shareholders, employees and agents from and against claims, damages, liabilities, costs and reasonable attorneys' fees arising out of (i) materials, permissions, information or specific instructions supplied by Client; (ii) allegations that claims, descriptions or representations regarding Client contained in Client-approved materials are false, misleading, unsubstantiated or contrary to applicable legal or regulatory requirements; or (iii) Client's acts or omissions. These obligations shall survive termination of this Agreement. Except for Client's indemnification obligations, neither party shall be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or punitive damages arising from this Agreement.

Each party's obligations under this Agreement are subject to applicable law and regulatory requirements. Agency shall not be required to undertake any activity that it reasonably determines would violate applicable law or applicable registration, disclosure, or compliance requirements.

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia.

The signing parties hereto acknowledge that they have received and reviewed the terms and conditions of this document. This Agreement is effective upon the signatures of both parties.
