Dear Mr. Katsuno:

This is to confirm the agreement whereby DiMarco-von Loewenfeldt Associates is being retained by the Consulate of Japan in San Francisco to function as public relations counsel responsible for promotion of trade and cultural relations in Northern California.

It is understood that DiMarco-von Loewenfeldt Associates will assume responsibility for the planning, preparation and dissemination of informational material to the various news media and be available for consultation on matters of public relations.

It is further understood that this agreement, effective this date, is to remain in force for an initial period of three months with continuation thereof being at the discretion of either party. However, it is agreed that sixty-days notice of cancellation shall be given in writing in the event of cancellation.

It is agreed that DiMarco-von Loewenfeldt Associates shall be paid a retainer fee of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) per month, and in addition will be reimbursed for production costs, said costs to be authorized and approved in advance by the Consulate of Japan before being incurred. Method of billing will conform with instructions from the Consulate.

If this letter is in accordance with your understanding of our agreement it will serve as our contract. Kindly sign the attached copy and return it to us for our files.
